

NAVY APPOINTMENTS--Vice-Admiral Jose (Cesar) de Oliveira will be invested as commander of the 1st Naval District, replacing Vice Admiral Ottavio Jose Sampaio Fernandez who has been appointed fleet commander in chief, replacing Fleet Admiral Jose de Carvalho Jordao. NINTH REGION COMMANDER--Gen Raimundo Ferrera de Sousa has been appointed new commander of the 9th Military Region in Amazonia. (Brasilia Domestic Portuguese 2200 GMT 1 Mar 71 C)

ANTIQUERRILLA MANEUVERS--Gen Francisco (Jimeno Vasques) de Aguiar, commander of the 3d Military Region will travel tomorrow to Santa Maria to attend the closing of military maneuvers or revolutionary warfare. The maneuvers are being conducted by units of the 3d Infantry Division posted in that city. (Brasilia Domestic Portuguese 2200 GMT 2 Mar 71 C)

INAUGURATION OF GENERATOR--President Medici and Governor Israel Pinheiro inaugurated the first generator unit of the Jaguarua hydroelectric complex in the Rio Grande on the border between the states of Minas Gerais and Sao Paulo. The dam will have six generators which will furnish a total of 684,000 kilowatts of power for Minas Gerais State. (Sao Paulo Radio Tupi Portuguese 0100 GMT 27 Feb 71 C)

NATIONAL INTEGRATION--Senator Virgilio Tavora said in Recife on 26 February that "the national integration plan does honor to the present Brazilian administration, and the keystone of it is the construction of the Transamazonic highway that will cost 400 billion cruzeiros, a sum supplied by the superintendency for the development of the Amazon area." He added that the project "is the most forward and serious step taken by the Brazilian Government to integrate the north and northeast." PARTY LOYALTY BILL-- Justice Minister Buzaid said in Brasilia on 26 February that he would discuss the principle of party loyalty with National Renewal Party President Joao Batista Ramos "to dispel doubts about the provision of the legislative bill that will be sent to congress early in April." MICROWAVE NETWORK--By the end of the year, all of Brazil will be linked by the microwave service, states communications Minister Higinio Corsetti. WAGE RAISE APPROVAL--For the first time since its reorganization, the national wage council met in Brasilia on 25 February with Labor Minister Cirne Lima presiding.
