He said he fought long and hard to continue flying these aircraft and when it became hopeless, took a thirty day leave and visited the U.S. When he returned the decision had been made and now he is beginning to clear out the supply and maintenance shelves so they can prepare for the new aircraft.

2. (C) The new aircraft will be configured for five crew members: pilot, copilot, navigator, radar/radio and ordnance. As Lt. Col. LOTT said, "this is not an ASW aircraft, but only a means of detecting and tracking surface ships within the 200 mile coastal area. In other words, we will be a coast guard force."

COMMENT: (U) These aircraft have had a history of logistic and, due to the age and location, corrosion problems. The Brazilians will scrap all the aircraft except one, which is to be mounted at the Salvador Air Base. Herein closes an era of some twenty years of "NEPTUNE" flying by the Brazilian Air Force.
