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VESSELS PATROLLING 200-MILE LIMIT INCREASED

[Text] The number of vessels patrolling the 200-mile limit off Brazil's southern coastline has been increased to 13, with the incorporation of the cutters Iranga and Iraque. Vice Admiral Jose Oliveira, commandant of the 1st Naval Zone, has stated that at least 50 cutters would be needed for regular patrolling.

Up to this time, 10 foreign--Japanese and French--fishing boats have been surprised operating within the 200-mile limit in the south. All the boats agreed to leave the Brazilian waters and there were no incidents. The boats were boarded off the coasts of the states of Santa Catarina and Rio Grande do Sul.
