

Every day, people are leaving the killing fields of Planned Parenthood. You know this. In fact, your literature constantly bemoans the loss of practitioners of abortion.

Ron Fitzsimmons is a leading advocate for abortion on demand. Several years ago, during the debate over partial-birth abortion, Fitzsimmons admitted that he had "lied through his teeth." He lied about the numbers and about the conditions.

In a way, I'm surprised that you send out letters seeking donations. Surely, you don't need the additional money. As the largest single provider of abortions – and you don't do them for free – your operations are hugely profitable. But you need to stain as many people as you can with your efforts. By the time they realize what they have supported, they have all too often morally compromised themselves and have stifled the voice of conscience.

I urge you to give up your huge subsidies from the U.S. Government. And I demand that you stop your libelous attacks on decent Americans who honor life and marriage. I appeal to you to stop maligning the good families who support Family Research Council.

Ms. Feldt, I offer you this challenge: Give up your huge federal subsidies and go out among the people to ask for their support, just as we do. Then, you will truly see whom they regard as extreme.
