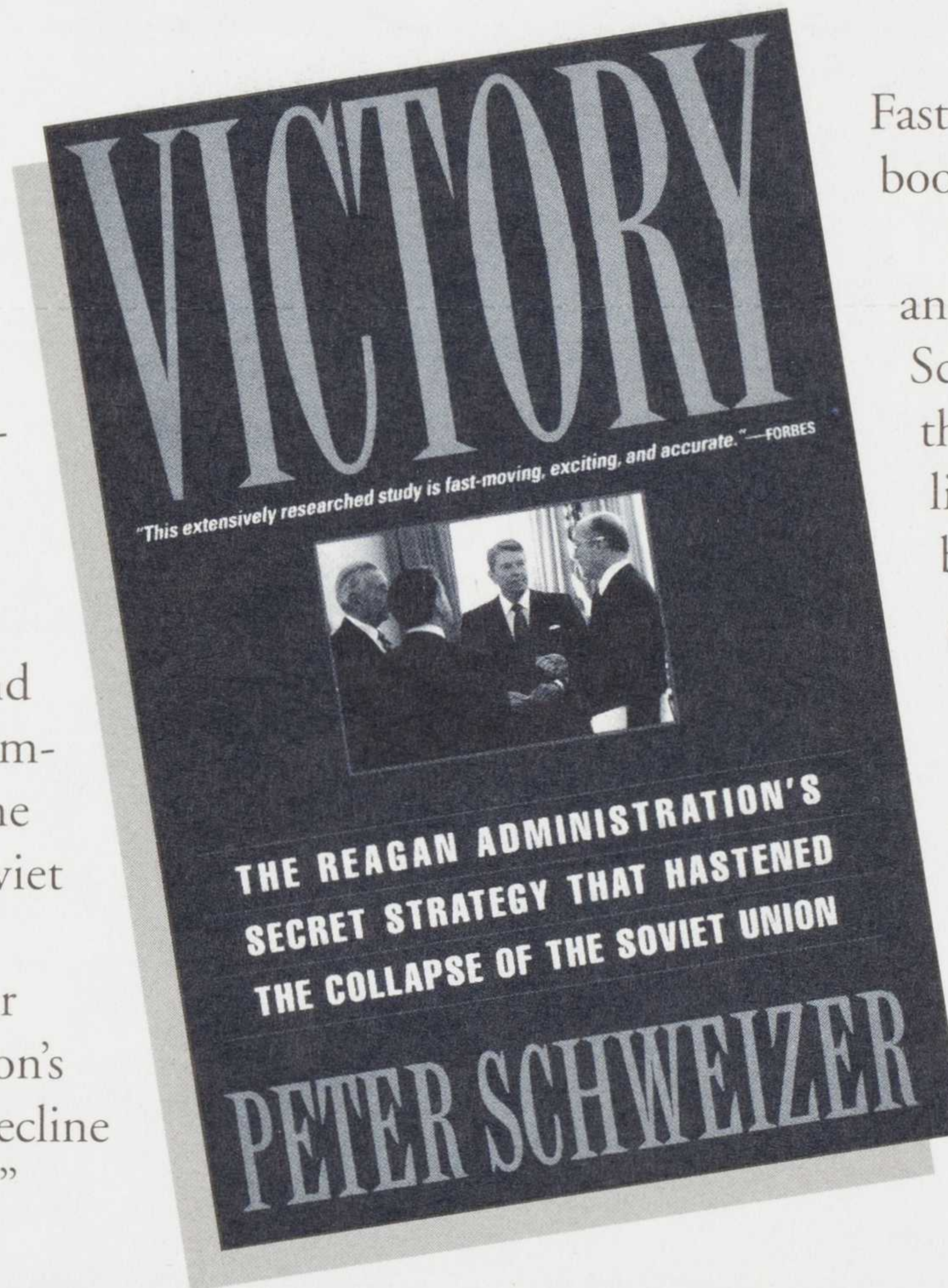


Reclaiming the Reagan Mantle
