

\$50.00: Israel and the New Covenant

For years I tried to find this book. Only a few thousand copies were ever printed in 1954. It was brought back in print just a few years ago. It is remarkably up-to-date. This book deals with the Christian concept of the future and with our duty as Christians in view of that future. *Israel and the New Covenant* is a remarkable book. It is filled with Bible verses, biblical exposition, and insights that bring the Bible alive. The footnotes alone are worth the price. The author quotes books that have been long out-of-print. The book moves from "Our Hebrew-Christian Heritage" to "War, Victory, and Peace." **Warning:** It was nearly 30 years before this book was brought back into print. After this printing is gone, you may not see it again.

\$75.00: Christianity and the Constitution

This is the first book on the Constitution that is self-consciously Christian. It is divided into three parts. Part I deals with the background of the Constitution: Calvinism, Puritanism, Deism, Freemasonry, and Science. Part II discusses the life, education, and beliefs of some of the most prominent men who worked on the Declaration of Independence and/or the Constitution. There are some very interesting insights in this section. Part III discusses the world view that brought the Constitution into existence, the Christian principles found in the Constitution, and what the Constitution means as we move into its third century. This is a very important and helpful book. John Eidsmoe, author of *The Christian Legal Advisor* has done a masterful job.

\$100.00: Doctrine of the Knowledge of God

This book is for the serious Christian reader. All of theology hinges on the doctrine of God. The sloppy theology that pervades much of the church today centers on a misunderstanding of who God is. This book will go a long way in clearing up the awful confusion. The author is professor of theology, apologetics, and ethics at Westminster Theological Seminary, Escondido, California. He has taught some of the most brilliant young men in the church today. Vern S. Poythress writes that *The Doctrine of God* is "The most important single book in theology to appear in the 20th century."
