

That the priest can impart virtue to water, salt, ashes, oil, scapulars, medals, crucifixes, bones, bottles, rags, feathers, roses and other papal junk.

That all those who are not married by a Roman priest, are not married, but living in adultery, and their children illegitimate.

Every one of the above statements are absolutely false, and contrary to the Word of God, the Bible, and one who can prove otherwise to the writer, he promises that he will never preach again.

This pamphlet would not be complete without presenting to Roman Catholics and others the way of salvation.

The first verse I want to call to your attention to is found in John 3:16, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." The word "whosoever" in this verse means the reader, be he Roman Catholic, Protestant or any one else.

The next verse will prove to you that there is no salvation to be found in any other than in Jesus Christ. "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved." Acts 4:12.

The very moment the reader believes in Christ, that moment he or she receives everlasting life which the

following verse clearly sets forth: "He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life; and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him." John 3:36. The one word in this verse I want to call to your attention to is the word "hath" which is in the present tense. There is another verse which emphasizes the same thing. You will find this one in John 5:24.

"Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on Him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life."

Remember that you have just read the words of Jesus.

Again in John 14:6, Jesus says, ". . . I am the way, the truth and the life: no man cometh unto the Father but by Me." Jesus does not say that the pope is the way, the priest or even the church, but He does say that He is the way. This verse as well as the others quoted you will find in the Roman Catholic Bible. Why not look it up for yourself and be convinced.

Again Jesus says "I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live." John 11:25.

My Roman Catholic reader, if you are not a real believer, you are dead in trespasses and sins, and if
