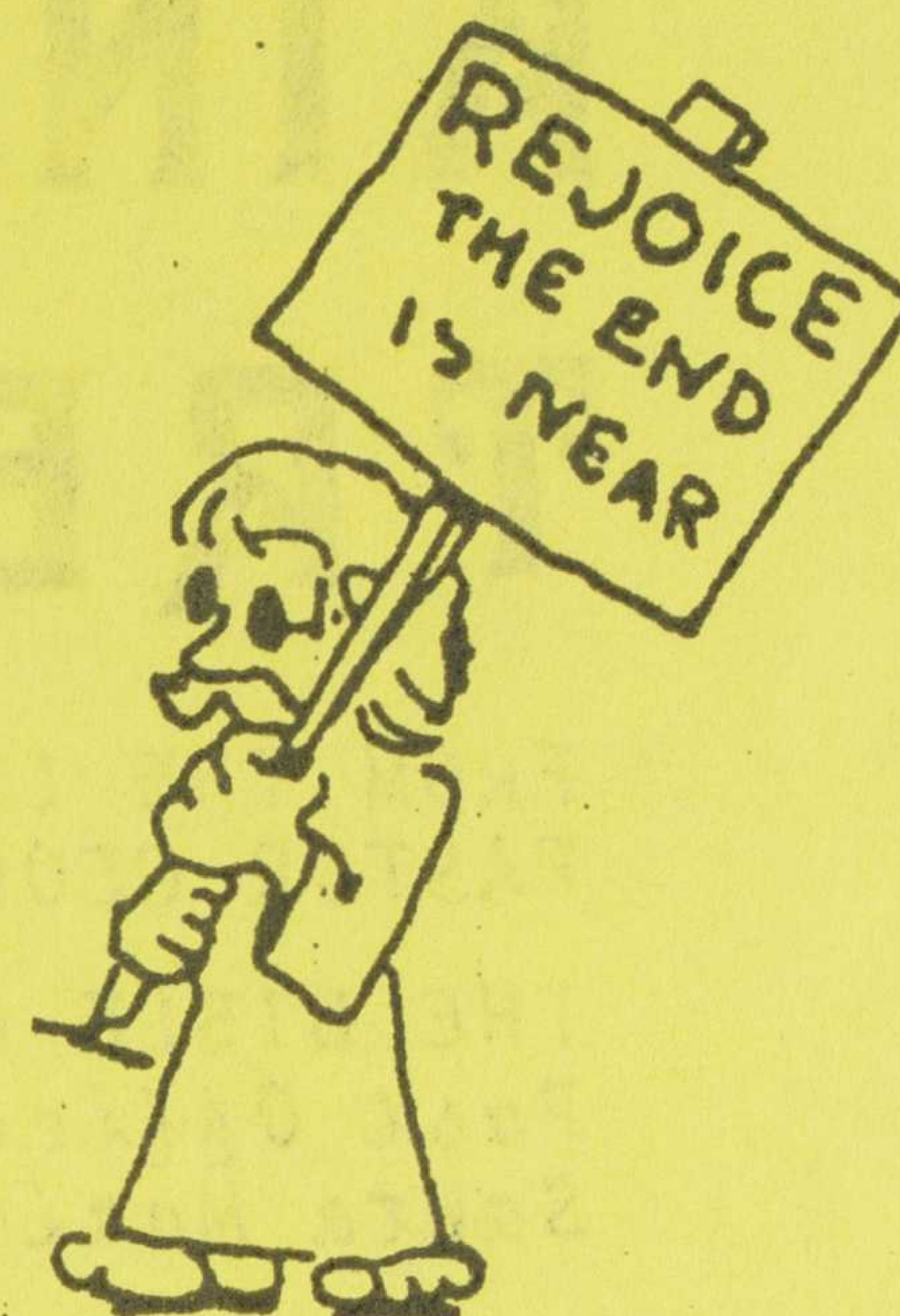




HOW DO YOU SEE?....

Bible Basics

Of Father Abraham it is said: "For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God." Hebrews 11:10. To that City, the 46th Psalm refers: "There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the City of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the Most High." 46:4.

Now that "City" is analogous to the spiritual Temple of which we read in Ephesians 2:20-21 "And are built upon the foundations of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone: in whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord."

This is, according to the Bible, The True City built upon the Rock, which is Christ. Now this mystical Temple or City of God is called ZION. "In Judah [the Tribe from which Jesus Christ came] is God known: his name is great in Israel. In Salem also is his tabernacle, and his dwelling place in Zion." Psalm 76:1-2
