

Although the California ruling does not directly apply to Randall, it is a significant precedent. This makes it all the more important and timely to press our representatives in the House and the Senate to void the discriminatory, anachronistic portions of McCarran-Walter.

Write letters to your representatives in both Houses of Congress expressing your outrage about the new INS ruling on Randall. Urge them to take this matter up with Alan C.
