What may result, is the emergence of a feud between the new Chief of Naval General Staff and the Admiral that relieved him as Secretary (2 General of the Navy. This report provides the details. 0 0 10 11 M 02 00 (U) On the afternoon of 2 May, Navy Minister Admiral (Ret) ADALBERTO de Barros MUNES arrived in Brasilia to preside at the Change of Command Ceremonies scheduled NUMES arrived in Brasilia to preside at the Change of Command Ceremonies scheduled the next day for the four top posts: Chief of Naval General Staff, Director General of Naval Personnel, Director General of Naval Material and Secretary General of the Navy. - 2. (U) At 1100, 3 May, the Navy Minister presided at a multiple Chang of Command Coremony involving the following Admirals:
- a. Admiral Geraldo Azevedo HENNING relieved Admiral HELIO Ramos d: Azevedo IEITE as Director General of Naval Personnel.
- b. Vice Admiral Arnaldo de Negreiros JANNUZZI relieved (interim) ..dmiral Octavio José SAMPAIO FERNANDES as Director General of Naval Material.
- c. Admiral Octavio José SAMPATO FERMANDES relieved Admiral José 6: Carvalho JORDAO as Secretary General of the Navy.
- (U) At 1600 on the same day, Admiral Jose de Carvalho JCKDÃO relic red Admiral ALCANTARA as Chief of the Naval General Starf. That evening the Navy Cinister hosted a farewell reception for Admiral ALCANTARA that was well attended by Navel officers stationed in Brasilia and representatives of the other Armed Forces.
- (C) Conspicuously absent from all the functions related to these (ommand Changes was Admiral Mauricio DANTAS TORRES, the Director General of N vigation, who lost out to Admiral JORDAO in the bidding for the top position of Chief of Maval General Staff/Chief of Maval Operations. His absence was to be expected. However, Admiral SAMPATO FERMANDES and the officers of his immediate staff also did not attend the Navy Minister's reception. Furthermore, unlike the other four-star admirals cited above, Admiral SAMPAIO FERNANDES did not ext nd his relief, Vice Admiral JAMMUZZI, the courtesy of receiving him at the a rport.
- COMMEND: (C) Admiral SAMPATO FERMANDES is apparently unhappy over being switched to the less prestigious Secretary General of the Mavy position. According to a Commander close to Vice Admiral JANNUZZI, Admiral SAMPAIO FERNANDES' taff reputedly intends to minutely review the records of Admiral JORDÃO's enure as Secretary General in an effort to uncover evidence of poor administration. The rivalry between these two submarine-qualified officers is intence and well known, although they appear friendly on the surface. Now it appears that Ad irral SAMPATO FERMANDES feels that Admiral JORDÃO did not support his remaining as Director General of Naval Material --- perhaps because as Secretary Ceneral he will not be in as good a position to challenge JORDÃO for the coveted May, Minister's post in the next Administration. Thus, it is reasoned that he will ϵ ideavor to discredit JCRDÃO's stewardship as Secretary General of the Navy. This rivalry with more than likely result in the neutralization of both these officers as a possible Navy Minister with the more successful being offered a seat on the Supreme Military Tribunal which becomes vacant next year with the statutory retirement of the incumbent. Both these officers are considered well disposed to the UNITED STATES, with Admiral SAMPAIO FERMANDES having the edge on personal alility and leadership. The snubbing Admiral SAMPATO FERNANDES gave his relief, Vice Admiral JAMNUZZI, has undoubtedly alienated the latter officer who becomes the next fourstar Admiral at the end of July. Coupled with the outcast status ac orded Admiral DANTAS TORRES, reunions of the Navy High Command in the next six months could prove to be scenes of discord and derisiveness. Whether or not this was intended by the politically astute Navy Minister is unknown, but it does streigthen his position and increases significantly his capacity to name his own su cessor.
