Brig. Frazão is a highly respected leader in BAF. He is intelligent and communicates extremely well. He understands English better than he speaks. He is a suave diplomat and he and his wife should be excellent representatives of Brazil in Washington, D.C. as the Air Attaché.

Remarks and actions of subject toward representatives of the United States and its allies, and to representatives of nonaligned nations and Communist bloc nationals. Political activities and attitudes, important political contacts, party affiliations, potential political influence in country in the event of a change in government.

He has always been very friendly with Americans. He is strongly nationalistic but diplomatic in his expression of other nations goals and aspirations. He is anti-communist in expressing his political beliefs. Party affiliation is unk. His actions appear to be motivated toward his military career and not for any political position or influence. It is not known if he has any important political contacts.

He is a neat well groomed individual who enjoys social contacts. He converses easily with new acquaintances. He is a relatively tall Brazilian with a medium to heavy frame. His hair is receding and thinning.

57. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON SPOUSE - Spouse's political views, appearance, personality, attitude toward United States and other countries, influence on husband. Spouse's family connections influencing the husband's career.

Mrs. Frazão speaks English fluently and is a charming person. She is very friendly with Americans. She taught Portuguese at the Joint Brazil-U.S. Military Commission during the late 50's and early 60's.

58. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

RO has known subject less than 1 week; however, previous AIRA has known subject off and on for 3 years but contact has been infrequent. Approximately 20% of info is based on personal contact. Other sources of information are official publications.

Brig. Frazão is a warm, sincere person. The best way to gain his confidence is a straight forward professional approach.
