USAEC/CNEN Matters of current interest

The Scientific Attaché called on the Acting Chairman of the CNEN on September 4: Professor Jonas Correia Santos. CNEW Chairman, Professor Luiz Cintra do Prado, is absent from Brazil in connection with the IAEA meeting in Vienna.

Among matters discussed were the following:

- The information provided in Department Airgram No. A-34, 1) concerning Wilma Hehl, was reviewed with Professor Jonas.
- Preliminary arrangements were made for a visit to Brazilian 2) installations by Dr. Lester R. Rogers, new AEC Scientific Representative for South America, headquartered in Buenos Aires. This visit is tentatively scheduled for early October after the return of the CNEN Chairman.
- Material in the form of copies of recent AEC publications: 3) RME-4546, "Reconnaissance for uranium in the Perus area, São Paulo, Brazil" were delivered at the request of Mr. John W. Gabelman, Chief, Resource Appraisal Branch, Division of Raw Materials, AEC, Washington.
- The Neutron Crystal Spectrometer for Brazil (Ref.: Deptel 4) 149; Embtel 236). Professor Jonas was not familiar with this. No new developments can be reported.


