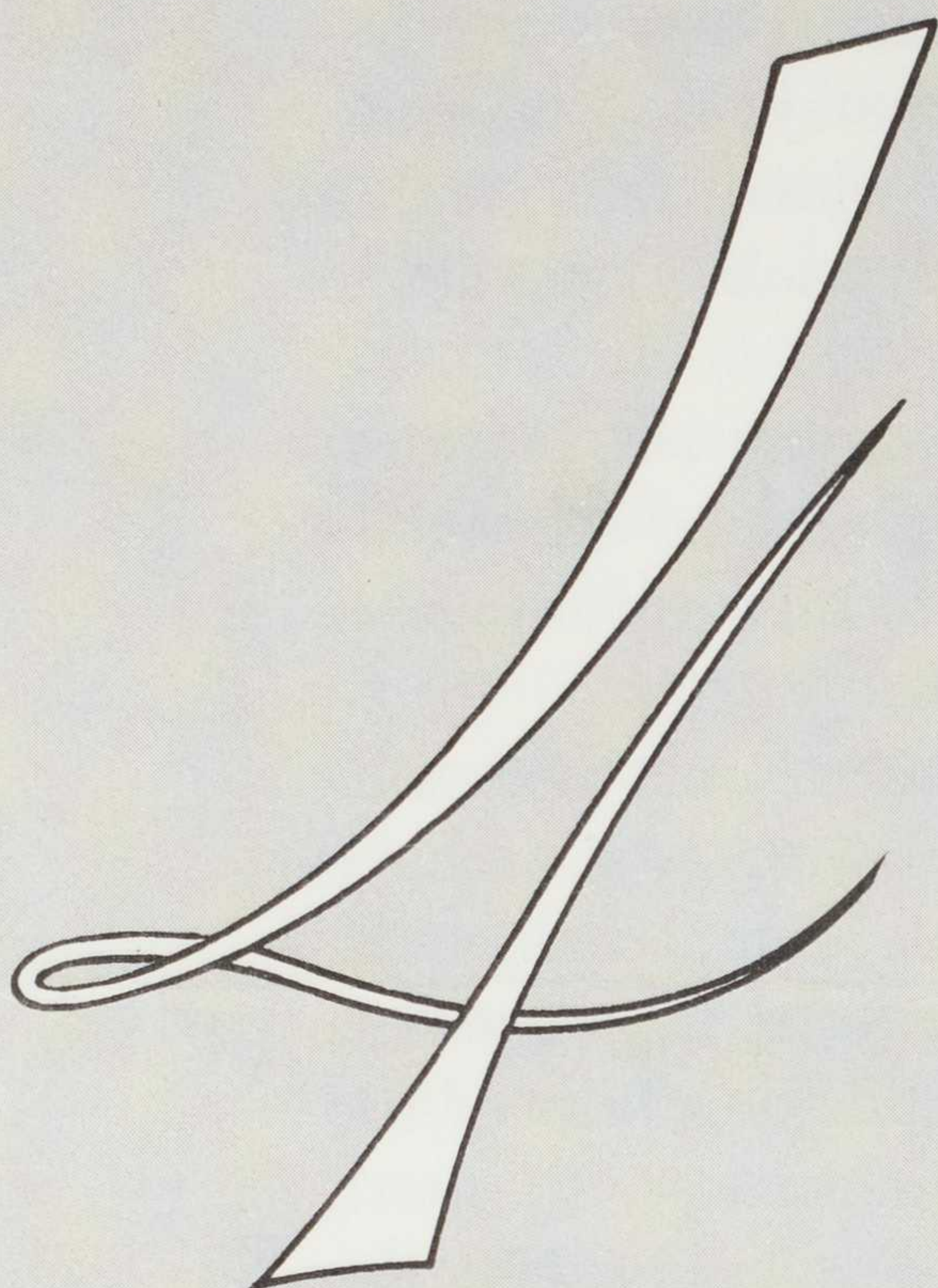

SUMMER SEMINARS AT FEE—1966

For the eighth year, FEE will conduct graduate-level seminars on its premises. Four are scheduled — co-educational and a week long, each. The beginning dates: June 19, July 10, July 24, and August 21.

These seminars are designed primarily for teachers of the social studies. But persons in other endeavors — business and professional men and women, as well as graduate students—are equally welcome.

Each seminar will consist of 40 hours of classroom lectures and discussions in economics and government, plus appropriate reading assignments. In addition to Dr. Benjamin A. Rogge, Percy Greaves, Jr., and the regular FEE staff, there will be several visiting professors of note.

The FEE charge for a seminar—including tuition, books, supplies, room, and board—is \$150. A number of fellowships (including partial travel grants) will be made available to high school and college teachers and administrators.

Individuals, companies, and foundations, interested in furthering this educational enterprise, are invited to make fellowship grants to teachers. Last summer, for example, fellowship and travel grants were made to 91 participants from 27 states—amounting to \$24,000.
