Mr. Boll said he would write a story, for the Evening Republican in Columbus, illustrated with this photo, mentioning our meeting in Lima, and discussion of CUMMINS Contribution to the Partners Program. He said Cummins can make available many diesel engines to our Program for Engineering and Mechanical Schools in Rio Grande do Sul. Please follow up this matter with Cummins.

I thank you in advance for your information on such a matter, and also about Rosalino Rossi case.


