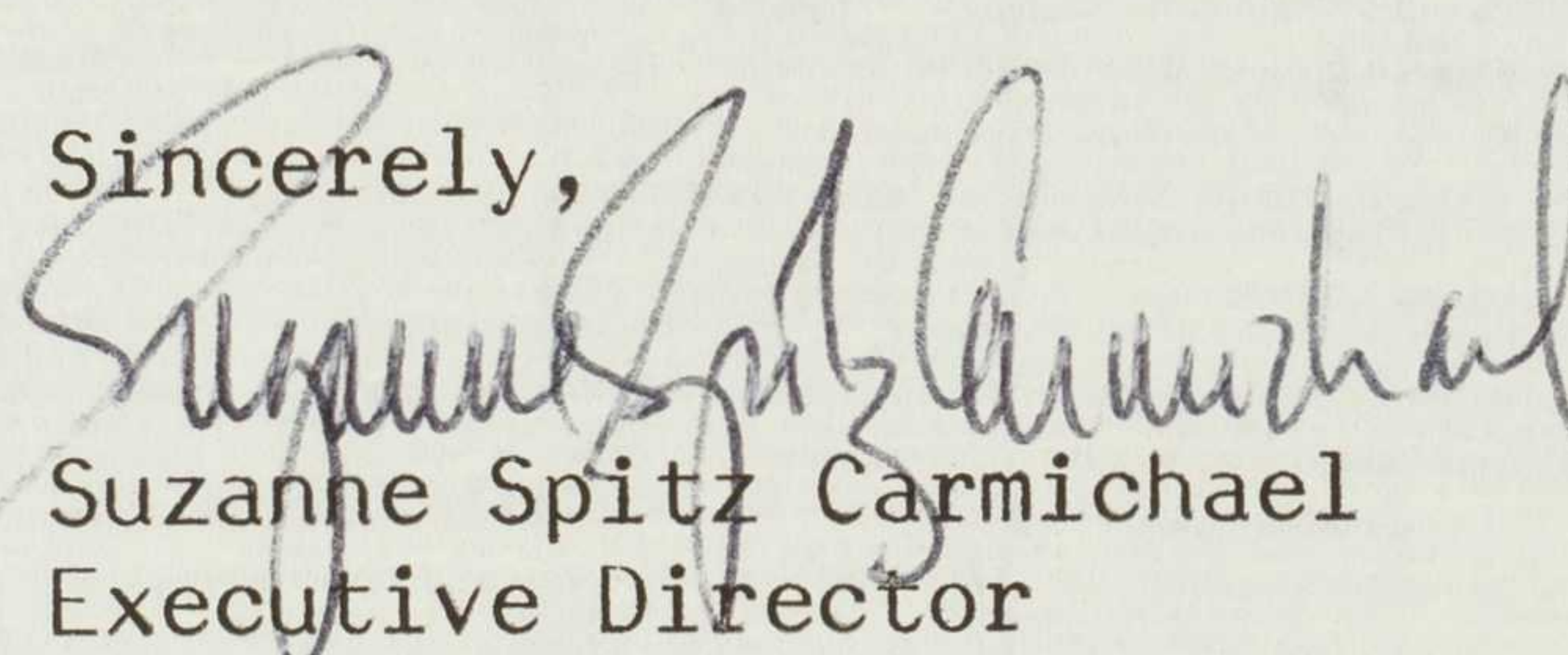

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The five grants we just awarded include:

Montana Pro-Choice Coalition \$4500 for their organizing work throughout Montana to promote freedom of choice concerning abortion.

Washington Coalition of Sexual Assault Programs \$1230 to provide funds for rape crisis centers and programs to send representatives to statewide Coalition meetings. The Coalition is working on social change issues such as polygraph, use of confidential records in prosecutions, etc.

Oregon Fair Share- \$5000 for their organizing work/coalition building with labor, senior citizen, public interest and other groups interested in obtaining lifeline energy rates and impacting the public debate on home heating oil costs.

Wyoming Outdoor Council -\$3280 for their Uranium project which involves organizing citizens to combat the boomtown effects and environmental problems caused by increased uranium prospecting and development in the Northwest and South Central portion of Wyoming.

Technical Assistance for Community Services (Portland, Oregon) \$1000 towards their excellent work in providing administrative training/assistance to social service/change oriented groups in the Greater Portland area.
