2. (C) HE MUST RETURNED FROM A VISIT TO BOLIVIA ON
18 OCT AND WILL BE GOING TO CHILE AS GUEST OF THE
CHIEF OF STAFF, CHILEAN AF. ON 3 NOVEMBER. THIS
VISIT WILL ALSO INCLUDE A STOP IN PARAGUAY. HIS
LAST OFFICIAL VISIT IS SCHEDULED FOR MID-NOVEMBER
WHEN HE WILL BE VISITING VENEZUELA.
COMMENT: (C) BRIG. PAULO SOBRAL, ONE OF THE OUTSTANDING
AIR FORCE LEADERS, IS HIGHLY RESPECTED BY THE MILITARY
PERSONNEL OF THE AMERICAS AND IS BEING GIVEN THE "RED
CARPET" TREATMENT PRIOR TO HIS DEPARTURE FROM
ACTIVE DUTY. THE VISITS THAT BRIG. PAULO SOBRAL IS
MAKING ARE VERY INTERESTING FROM THE STANDPOINT OF
PAST HISTORICAL EXPERIENCE AND FOR THE POSSIBLE
FUTURE RAMIFICATIONS, FIRST BOLIVIA AND PARAGUAY
