D. BG ANTONIO HAMILTON MOURAO REPLACES WERNER ON THE GENERAL STAFF, BRASILIA.

E. BG HEITOR LUIZ GOMES DE ALMEIDA LEAVES THE 4TH CAVALRY DIVISION TO ASSUME COMMAND OF THE 1ST MOTORIZED INF BRIGADE AT THE VILA MILITAR IN RIO DE JANEIRO.

F. MG ALOYSIO GUEDES PEREIRA, PASSED-OVER TWICE AND HIS REQUESTED RETIREMENT.

G. BG JOAO JOCOBUS PELLEGRINI, RETIRED DUE TO AGE (62).

H. BG MANOEL JOSE CORREA DE LACERDA, RETIRED DUE TO AGE (62).

I. GEN. RODRIGO OCTAVIO JORDAO RAMOS, NOMINATED FOR THE SUPERIOR MILITARY TRIBUNAL IN THE VACANCY OF GEN. (RET) ADALBERTO PEREIRA DOS SANTOS, VICE-PRESIDENT DESIGNATE IN THE NEXT ADMINISTRATION. GEN. RODRIGO OCTAVIO IS EXPECTED TO LEAVE HIS POSITION AS CHIEF OF THE SERVICES DEPARTMENT IN LATE SEPTEMBER

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OR EARLY OCTOBER. 4. (C) THE PROMOTION OF GEN. RAMIRO HAS A FAINT AIR OF CONTROVERSY ATTACHED TO IT. IN THE FIRST PLACE, THE PASSED-OVER GEN. ALOYSIO IS POPULAR, A DEDICATED SOLDIER AND AN INFANTRYMAN. RAMIRO IS AN OUTSTANDING PROFESSIONAL, BUT HE IS SOMEWHAT OF AN OPPORTUNIST AND REPRESENTS THE FOURTH CONSECUTIVE CAVALRYMAN ELEVATED TO FOUR STARS. THE FACT IS THAT RAMIRO IS NOW A MEMBER OF THE ARMY HIGH COMMAND WITH TENURE UNTIL NOVEMBER, 1976, WHEN HE COMPLETES TWELVE YEARS AS A GENERAL OFFICER.

5. (C) THE NEW BRIGADIER GENERALS ARE COMPETENT PROFESSIONALS, EVEN THOUGH CAMPBELL AND IRULEGUI ARE NOT WIDELY ESTEEMED AMONG THEIR COLLEAGUES. FERDINANDO IS A TOWER OF EXTRAORDINARY PROFESSIONAL STRENGTH AND MUST BE FLAGGED AS A MAN WITH ENORMOUS POTENTIAL IN THE YEARS' AHEAD.

COMMENT: (C) THE UPCOMING END OF NOVEMBER PROMOTIONS WILL BE AMONG THE MOST EXCITING OF RECENT YEARS AS THEY BRING INTO FOCUS A "NEW BREED" OF CANDIDATE. FOR THE FIRST TIME IN YEARS, MEN OF 67 (GEN. EULER BENTES MONTEIRO) AND 69 (GEN. REYNALDO WELLO DE ALMEIDA) WILL BE IN THE RUNNING FOR FOUR STARS. THE CONTROVERSIAL GEN. MEIRA MATOS COMES UP FOR HIS THIRD STAR, AND THE ELIGIBLE COLONELS ARE BRIGHT AND ATTRACTIVE. MOREOVER, IT WILL BE THE LAST OPPORTUNITY FOR PRESIDENT MEDICI AND ARMY MINISTER GEISEL TO "REWARD" SOME OF THEIR FAVORITES FOR SERVICES RENDERED DURING THE PAST FOUR YEARS. GDS 31 DEC 73

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
