

JOIN US in demanding that the Reagan administration and Congress act now to:

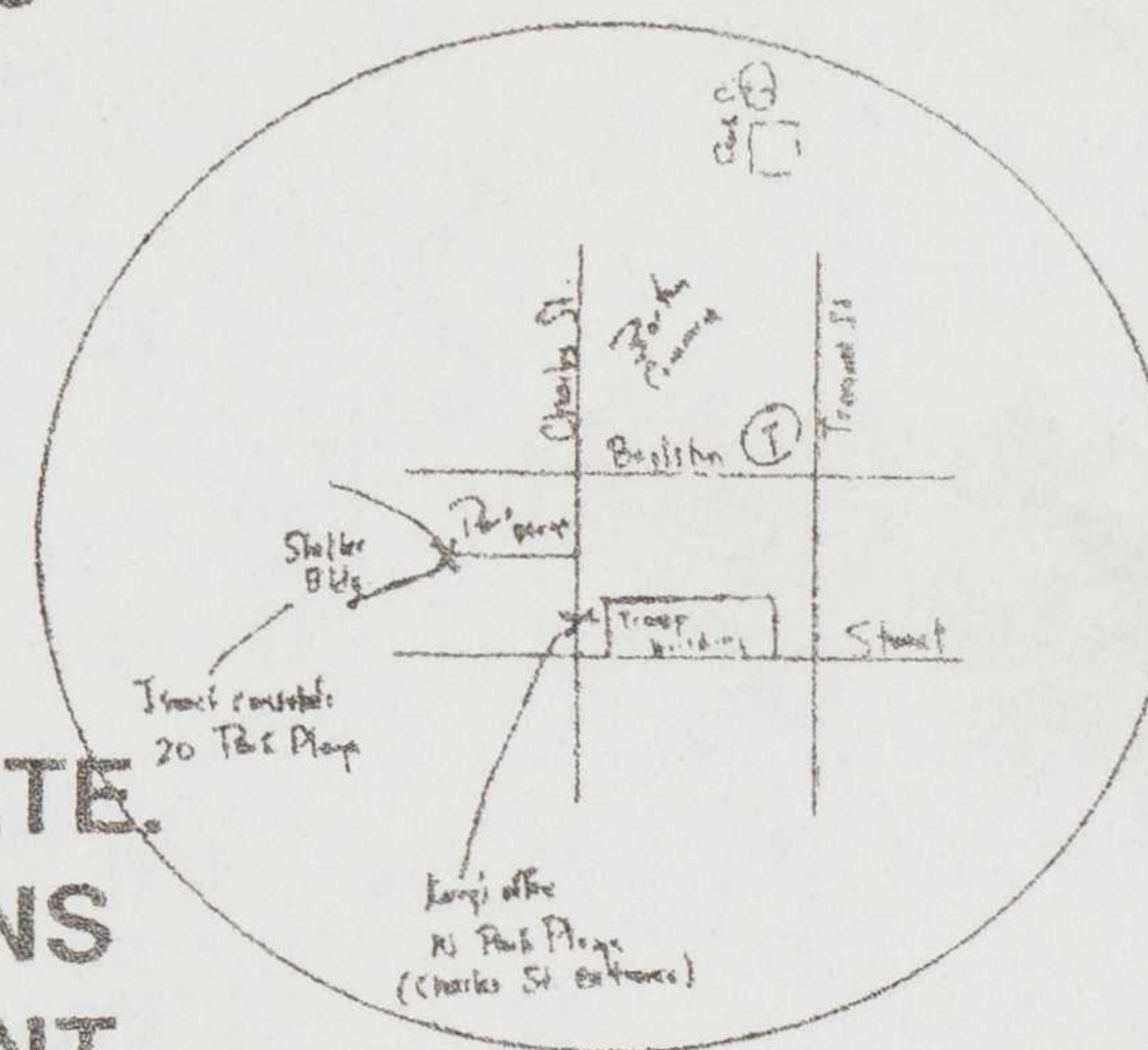
- Stop the deportation of Palestinians.
