IRS chases 2-cent penalty

LIVEMORE (AP) — The Internal Revenue Service says Frank Steele still owes 2 cents for a late payment penalty on his 1982 income tax - plus \$252.01 in interest. A letter from the IRS asks Steele to "please pay it today" and adds that if he doesn't remit the full amount within 10 days, "additional interest and penalties may be charged." Steele, 27, said he isn't about to pay. Not, at least, until he has talked with his attorney. "I wouldn't think they would go back five years for 2 cents," the frustrated Steele said.
