

out of its sixty million inhabitants, our newspaper evangelism effort costs \$2,000 a month to support. But the gospel is entering Muslim homes where no Christian would ever be allowed.

According to our co-workers there, more than half of the people who enroll in Bible correspondence courses do so because of gospel ads.

Listen to some of the testimonies that we receive. The following is from Russia: "Dear kind people who have set me on the right path and helped me to learn more about God. Thank you very much for the New Testament which I got from you."

"From the very beginning, as I studied these lessons, I felt that I was not alone and God was always with me," writes a respondent from the Buddhist country of Thailand. "I have peace and know about forgiveness. I thank God for giving me a new life."

People are crying for help and are thirsty for the truth. "For many years I have subscribed to the newspaper *Trud*, and in January I read a small article entitled 'Light in the Darkness,' that you placed. I really do want to know more about Jesus Christ our Lord," writes a reader. "Please help me to acquire faith," writes another.
