

The Board conducts TAA business in between the annual general sessions and meets twice a year under the chairmanship of the TAA President. Members of the Board of Directors are elected at the annual general meeting upon expiration of their staggered three-year terms with one-third of the board's membership elected at each annual meeting. A smaller executive committee comprised of the officers of the corporation meets at more frequent intervals.

Headquartered in Washington, D.C., the day-to-day operations of the Association plus year-round program development is handled by a professional staff. Backed by years of service in other nations, the Washington office is directed by an Executive Vice President with Associate Directors responsible for specific program development. They stand ready to assist any individual, organization or community wishing to join the program, or already active in it.
