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On Friday, May 23, 1969 the Brazilian Ministry of Foreign Affairs informed the Embassy that henceforth administrative and technical personnel who are citizens of the United States and not permanent residents of Brazil may import a privately-owned vehicle under the same terms and conditions as those applied to accredited diplomatic and career consular personnel. In other words, the administrative and technical personnel mentioned above may import a second vehicle after the first vehicle imported has been disposed of in accordance with Brazilian regulations and laws set forth in Embassy Instruction No. 281.

The Ministry also stated that it expects that administrative and technical personnel will continue to arrange to import their first vehicle into Brazil within six months after their arrival in the country.

Sub-paragraph II of Embassy Instruction 281 of September 13, 1968 is hereby cancelled.
