ORIGINATOR'S COMMENTS: The promotions to vice admiral followed the conservative line typical of the Brazilian Navy keeping close to the seniority list. No major surprises were evidenced. The same applied to the promotions in the staff corps and marine corps. The promotions to rear admiral (line) did dip and many were passed over, a total of nineteen captains to be exact. The major group affected were those captains assigned to the Armed Forces General Staff (EMFA). Three captains were in the promotion zone, none were selected. Among the selectees for rear admiral (line) is CAPT Geraldo Sylvio CRAVO Guimaraes, the last Brazilian officer to graduate from the United States Naval Academy.
