In the course of the conversation with the Scientific Attaché on September 24 (see Embassy A-306 of September 30, 1964), Dr. Isaias Raw of São Paulo, advised that he was taking two weeks vacation and that he planned on spending this time in the United States. He departs on October 2. He will be in the Washington area for the period of October 6 - 9.

The Embassy and the AID Mission would like to suggest that arrangements be made for him to meet with the following officers who, it would appear, have substantive interest in the effective collaboration which Dr. Raw has provided in the past and which he offers to continue in the future, in the broad program of the strengthening of science teaching in Brazil:

- AID/W - Dr. Leona Baumgartner, AA/TCR;  
Dr. Irving G. Tragen, LA/ID;  
Mr. Thomas W. Hazard, LA/ID;
- STATE - Dr. John K. Rouleau, Science Officer, SCI.
- NAS - Dr. Harrison Brown, Foreign Secretary;  
Dr. William Paddock, Head, Latin American Affairs, in connection with the Latin American Science Board of the Academy, advisory to AID;

Policy-wise it is suggested that an appointment also be set up to enable Dr. Raw to have some conversation with Ambassador Elsworth Bunker.



Minister Bond stated that Dr. Raw has been very helpful to them in the Consulate recently in a number of ways. He agreed that Washington should be notified of his coming trip.

FYI. Dr. Raw added rather whimsically, when he advised about his vacation and trip to the States, that one reason for his decision to go was just to prove to his detractors that he is in good standing and could get Presidential approval to travel overseas. End FYI.
