Information already available demonstrates that Simonsen and Jafet groups are presently works under attack and Recife's A-98 indicates Mattarazzo and Votorantim groups may soon come under similar attack. Power of these groups is of such magnitude that their destruction could be expected have important repercussions on Brazilian economy and body politic. Accordingly, would appreciate Embassy's evaluation of extent, nature, motivations and likely repercussions this phenomenon. Also suggest that Embassy consider updating its excellent dispatch no. 758 of December 13, 1955, which is still the Markinikia definitive work on this subject.
