1. Above replies indicate all Foreign Ministries consulted have shown interest in suggestion contained ref Circular subject to further study, with following variants:

(a) Guatemala having some difficulty assembling evidence of direct Cuban support for guerrillas but plans present what evidence available, without making issue of Guatemalan case;

(b) Colombia would not be able present documented case since there is "evidence", but not such as to constitute "proof", of Cuban involvement in subversion in Colombia; however will consider at least making references to Cuban support in speech or other statement at MFM; (c) Peru interested and will study;

(d) Bolivia reacted positively, indicating Bolivian military will share information on guerrilla activity with MFM.

2. In giving further encouragement this idea, request you explain that in our view documentary evidence or "proof" (along lines Venezuelan case) would not be essential to statements submitted by other governments. Hence we think government should feel free to submit factual and analytical statement with or without further documentation, as it sees fit. Whether presentation is included in speech or in separate written statement, would be useful to have it in such form as could be referred to as one of conference documents, supplementing investigating committee report on Venezuelan case.
3. For Santo Domingo. We have given COAS Rep del Rosario copy of paper prepared here on basis de la Rosa and other documents, with suggestion this might be useful in preparing statement as above. Del Rosario interested and ^{left} ~~sent~~ ^{for} copy/~~to~~ Foreign Minister during (Copy pouched Embassy) airport stopover June 27./ Request ~~Embassy~~ Embassy follow up and report
4. For Lima. If GOP reticent because of liquidation guerrilla problem, we think statement covering Cuban support of guerrillas in recent past would still be useful, to which could be added current activities, including (quechua broadcasts, etc.
5. For Caracas. Suggest you encourage GOV support this idea in other five capitals.
6. For all addressees. Request you repeat future messages on this suggestion, info other addressees.
