- 1. Mrs. Carter's Visit to Brazil: Embassy Brasilia comments that Mrs. Carter's trip was very successful in getting across to senior Brazilian officials the basic foreign policy concepts of the administration especially on human rights, nuclear proliferation, LDC-DC cooperation in reducing the gap between rich and poor, and the importance of strengthening interaction among the countries of the hemisphere. - 2. Mrs. Carter's Meeting with Colombian President Lopez:
 Mrs. Carter's meeting with Lopez covered human rights,
 nuclear non-proliferation, narcotics control, bilateral
 relations with Cuba and foreign relations. (Bogota

- 3. Vance-Carvajal Meetings: Embassy Santiago provides updated backgrounder for Vance's upcoming meeting with Chilean Foreign Minister Carvajal. (Santiago 4815)
- 4. Flag Tours: Embassy Bonn doubts that the Soviets will create an incident by stopping allied patrol vehicles at Checkpoint Charlie in the near future. However, the embassy believes we should continue to pursue contingency planning and be ready for some sort of Soviet-GDR pressures, at least in the form of harrassment or further senior level protests.
