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GOB spokesmen have made it clear that no further lists of individuals subject to Article 10 sanctions are forthcoming following those announced June 13 and June 14. (It seems possible, however that a few before hitherto unpublished in non-authoritative newspaper reports may be revealed within next few days when MWNAL: Diario official publication takes place.)

There is presently some question about total number of individuals accepted by Article 10. O Jornal of June 16 headlined that "purge reached 494 during 60 days." Jornal Do Commercio of same date published recapitulation of 314 names (among which there were several duplicates.) Embassy's own count to date shows 378 individuals who lost mandate and /or had political rights suspended in BARYRINJMW: attempting to obtain official recapitulation of Article 10 actions.

In related item, Marshal Taurino Resende Neto cited in Jornal do Brasil of June 16 as having indicated that he is unaware of how many Quadros-initiated investigations had now been rushed over to his investigating committees. Resende Neto further reported as not knowing "if there are still prisoners in spite of his ruling that all except those who had preventive prison decreed should be released".

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
