1. N POLLOWING 6 HOUR AND THEN 4 HOUR (ON SUCCESSIVE SHIFTS) WORK STOPPAGE JANUARY 13, COMMUNIST INFLUENCED UNION AT NATIONAL AIRPORT CALLED 48 HOUR STRIKE JANUARY 14-15 AMONG TECHNICAL AND COMMUNICATIONS EMPLOYEES IN SUPPORT DEMANT 400 PERCENT WAGE HIKE OVER 90 PER CENT ALREADY PROPOSED BY GOU.

2. DURING STRIKE ONLY MILITARY AMBULANCE FLIGHTS, AND INCOMING CIVIL FLIGHTS WHICH HAD ORIGINATED BEFORE STRIKES AND WORK STOPPAGES CALLED WERE PERMITTED. HOWEVER, DURING TIMES UNION HELD ASSEMBLIES STRIKE WAS TEMPORAPILY LIFTED AND, INTERMITTENTLY, SOME INTERNATIONAL TRAFFIC FLOWED INTO MONTEVIDEO.

3. ACCORRIMB PRESS GOU TOURIST AUTHORITIES CLAIM STRIKE ALREADY INTERRUPTED TRAVEL NEARLY 900 FOREIGN VISITORS EACH DAY, AND IF STRIKE CONTINUES OVER LONG PERIOD IT COULD FESULT IN SERIOUS EMBOFFICE OSS TOURIST REBNUE.
