

AN OPEN LETTER

TO REV. WALLACE L. WILSON

Pastor of the Renton Highlands Community Church

DEAR SIR: The treatment I received at your church when I recently passed out sound Christian literature; badly needed in this evil day of falling away from the Truth, was indeed a shock and revelation to me as to how far Christian leaders have departed from the "*faith once delivered to the saints*". (Jude 3). I found that your deacons along with yourself have gotten so far away from needed truth for this evil day, that you cannot appreciate the misery of distance.

I was threatened with arrest by one of your deacons! This might be expected from bigoted priests or protestant apostates, but when Christian leadership uses such tactics they only display the same evil spirit that actuates haters of truth outside the Christian Church.

My experience at your church gave me a real insight into the spiritual bankruptcy of yourself and your deacons. You did not even have the common courtesy or backbone to meet and talk with me, when your deacons desired it!

Spurgeon once said that it would be a blessing to the Church if a few hundred of her preachers were slaughtered. We sincerely believe that the only hope of Revival or purification of the Church today would be a Communist 'take over' and the slaughter of a thousand of her fundamentalist "little popes".

The blood of the martyrs has always been the true seed of the Church. This would drive the church 'underground' as well as separate from her an exceedingly huge amount of chaff which is helping to drag her down to the level of the world.

This would also drive true Christians into a closer union and fellowship with their Blessed Lord and Saviour; and free them from these 'little popes', and give them the chance to really believe what the Bible teaches without world pandering preachers explaining it away.

Such true men of God as John Bunyan, Wesley, Whitefield, and many more such down to Spurgeon and Moody, had no Bible school or theological training. These men were all taught of God and were not turned away from "*the simplicity that is in Christ*", by the schools of men. These men in their turn were all ordained of God and raised up to overthrow a protestant (Fundamental) clergy that had gone to seed. They brought new life and blessing to the nation that had sunk very low spiritually, morally and politically.

Wesley and Whitefield brought in a great revival because they were not the servants of men or Caesar. They preached the Word of God in all its purity in the power of the Holy Ghost. The results were that England was lifted out of a condition comparable or even worse than the U.S.A. is now in. The outcome was that she became a great and powerful protestant nation, that God honored in many ways.

A century later England had again sunk into a very low place because of a dead and worldly Church, God raised up C. H. Spurgeon, a true man of God, to overthrow a dead and corrupted Church, whose preachers hated and persecuted him to the limit. But God was with him and used him to overthrow these corrupted churches. Again England was revived spiritually, and also of course morally and politically, which is always the fruit of a true and living ministration of the Word of God. England was put on her feet and became a great nation—the mistress of the seven seas; opening up the entire World to the greatest missionary era since apostolic days.

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
