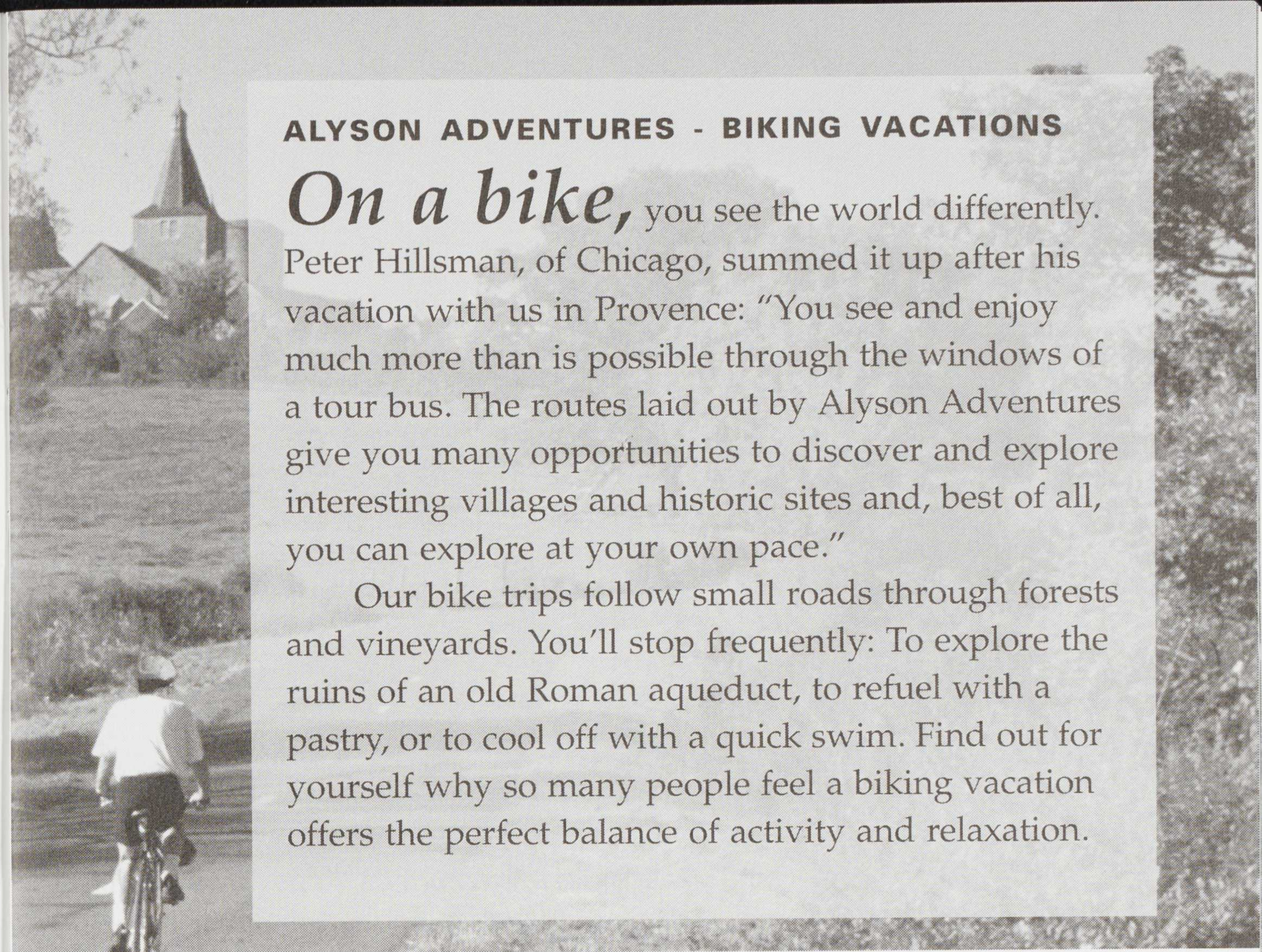

Price of each bike trip includes:
