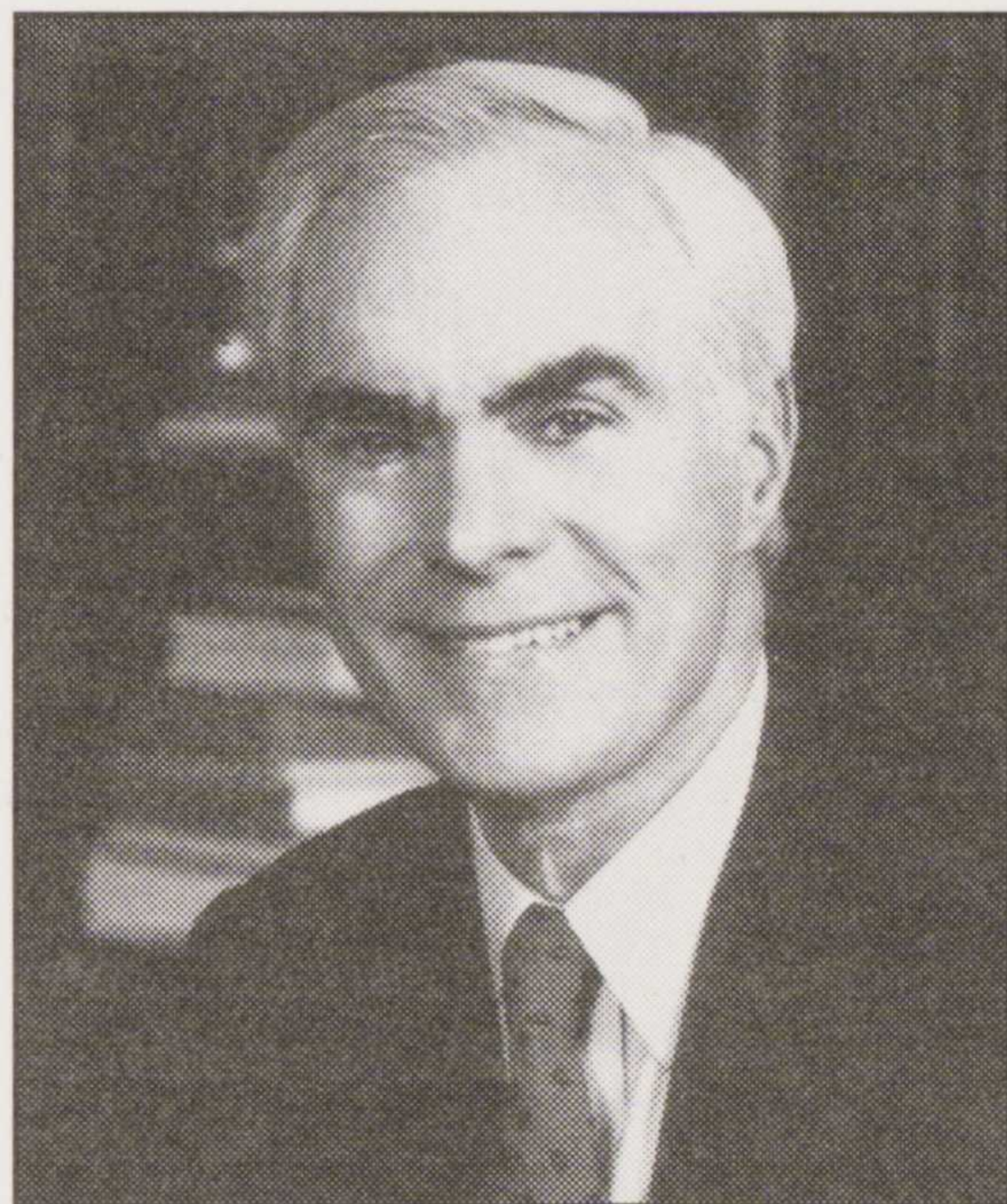




THE SPEAKER YOU WEREN'T ALLOWED TO HEAR

In 1992, then-Pennsylvania Gov. Bob Casey, reelected in 1990 by a million-vote margin, was barred from speaking at the Democratic National Convention. Why? Because of the powerful pro-life message he planned to deliver to the assembled delegates. Last month, former Gov.
