

JUSTICE FOR MARK CURTIS

Come to the Defense Rally in Cambridge, MA Monday, June 27



Mark Curtis holding one of the secret files the FBI was forced to release proving he was a target of their illegal operation against the Committee in Solidarity with the People of El Salvador. The "crime" of Mark and thousands of others was opposing the war in Central America. The Des Moines cops who beat Mark Curtis March 4 knew about his political activity. One said, "You're one of those Mexican lovers aren't you? Just like you love those coloreds." They beat him with a club that shattered his cheek bone and inflicted deep cuts around his left eye.

Political and union activist Mark Curtis was brutally beaten and framed up on false charges by the Des Moines police March 4. He faces a 25-year mandatory sentence if convicted of the burglary and attempted rape charges invented by the cops.

Thousands of protests have been sent. The police say they are "baffled" by the international concern.

The protests prove: AN INJURY TO ONE IS AN INJURY TO ALL.

Mark Curtis, 29 years old, is an active union member at the Swift/Monfort meat packing house where he works, and a fighter for the rights of immigrants, women and minorities. He is the former National Chairperson for the Young Socialist Alliance.

He was arrested, beaten and framed-up only a few hours after leaving a meeting with co-workers to protest a federal raid at Swift where 17 immigrant workers were arrested.
