- held symposia on the medical effects of nuclear war throughout the United States;
- conducted voter education programs including candidate forums and debates;
- formed national and local coalitions with professional and other like-minded groups;
- launched study groups on such issues as the Comprehensive Test Ban;
- published original research on low level radiation, civil defense planning, and the psychological effect of the arms race;
- joined Soviet and other physicians in an international debate on nuclear war prevention as the United States affiliate of International Physicians for the Prevention of Nuclear War;
- toured the country with nationally known physicians and scientists;
- activated a legislative alert network; and
- promoted nuclear war education in over 80% of American medical schools.

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
