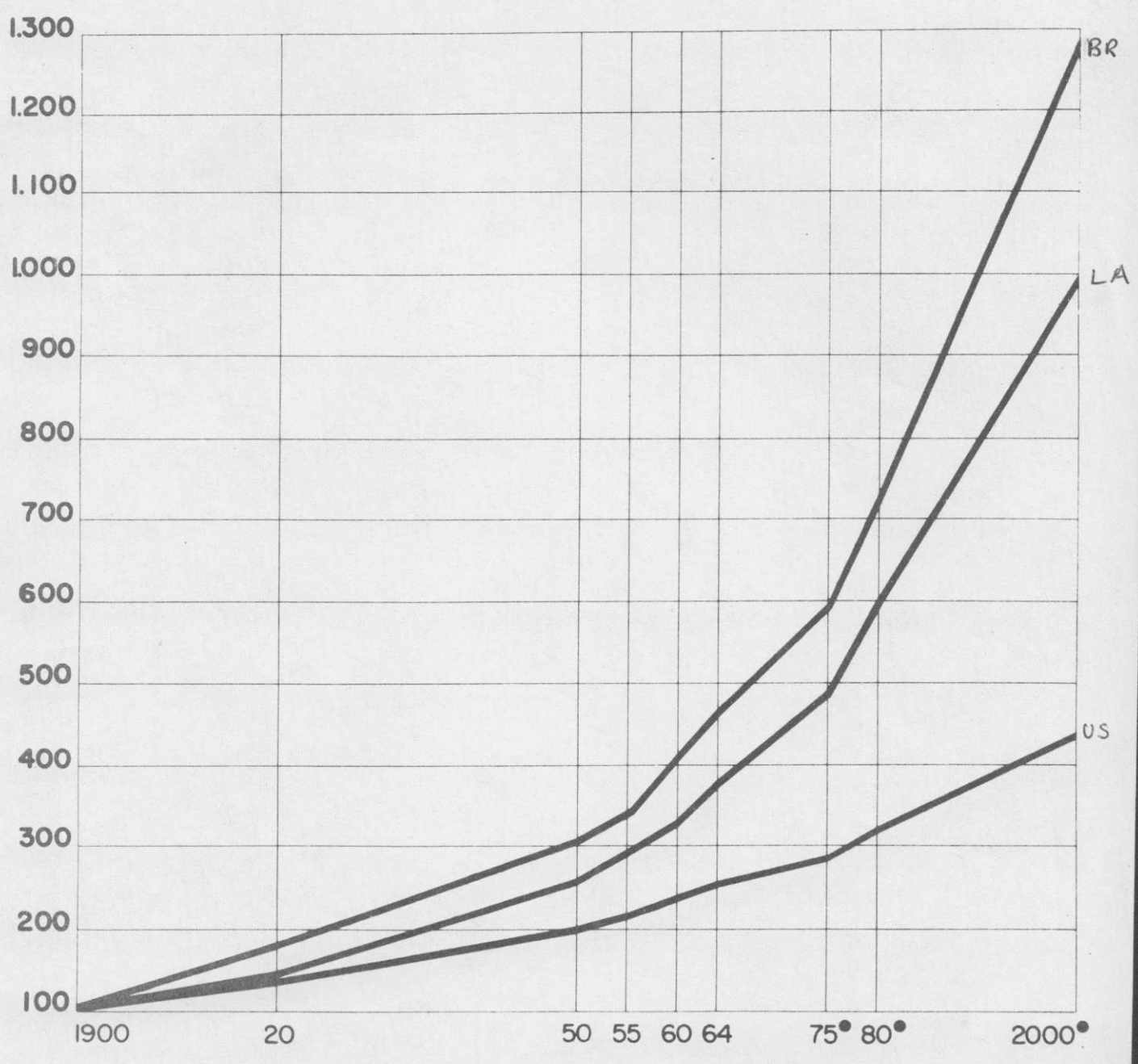


INDEX OF POPULATION GROWTH

● PROJECTIONS, BASED ON CURRENTLY ANTICIPATED GROWTH RATES (MEDIUM ESTIMATES)

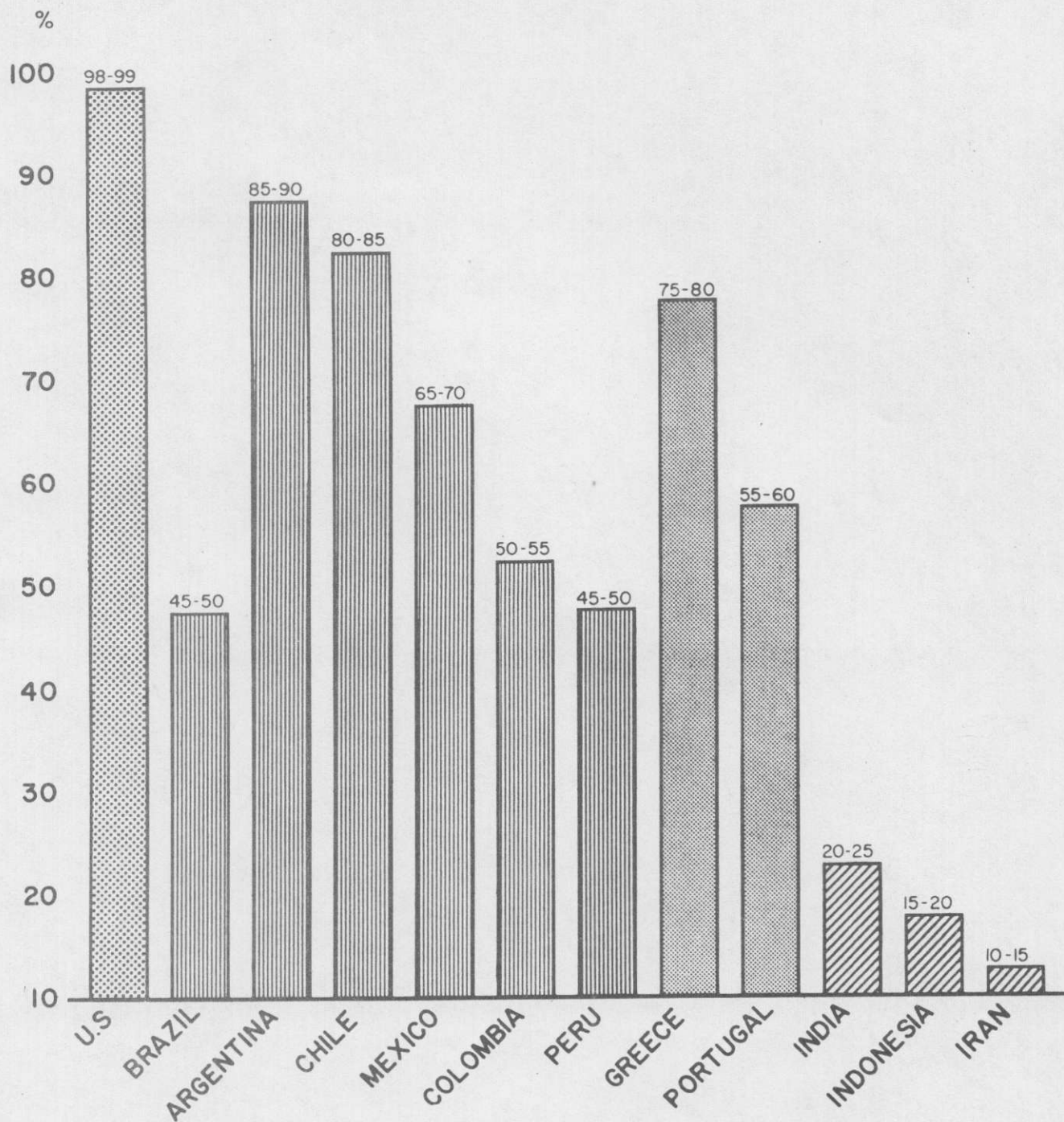

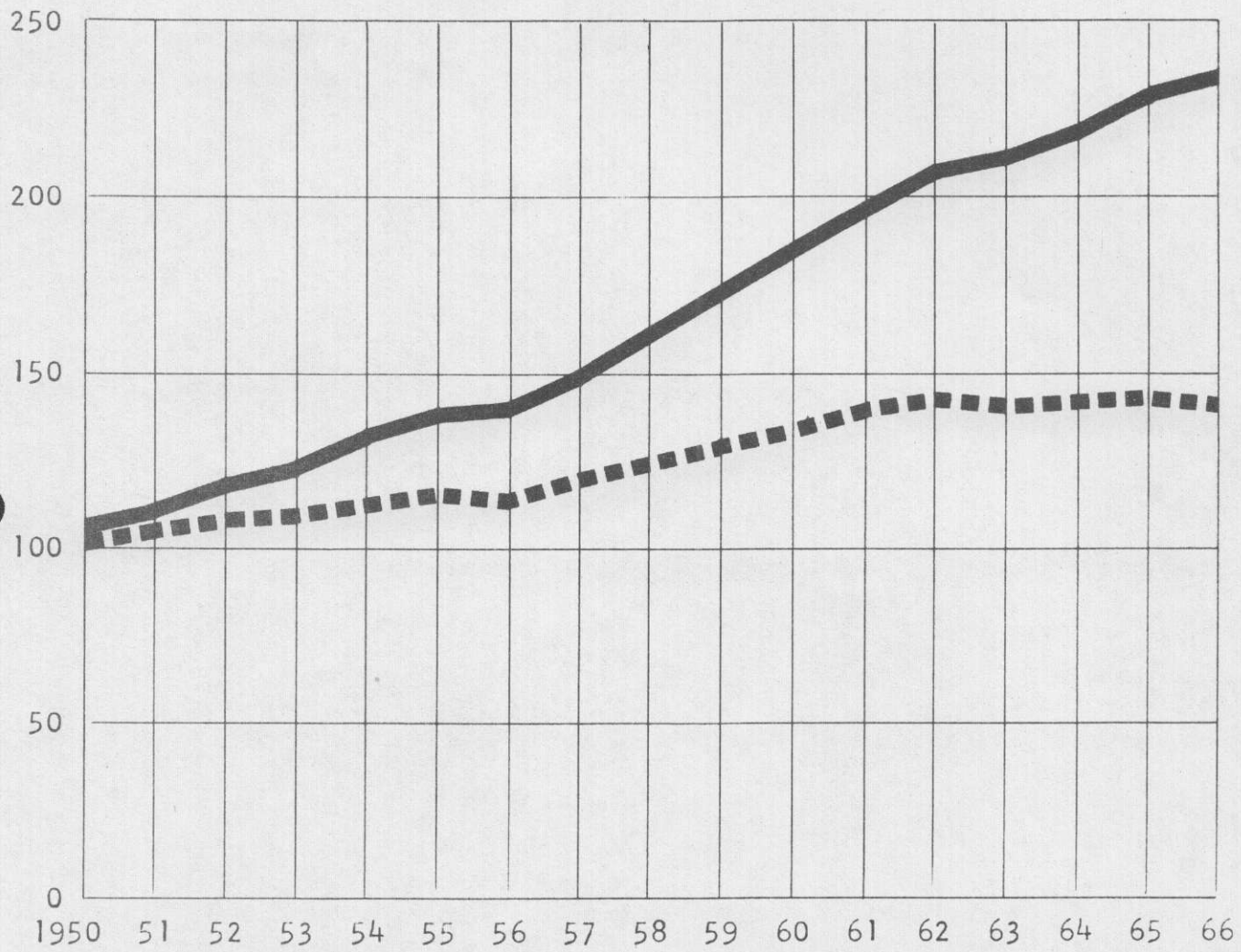

1950-1966

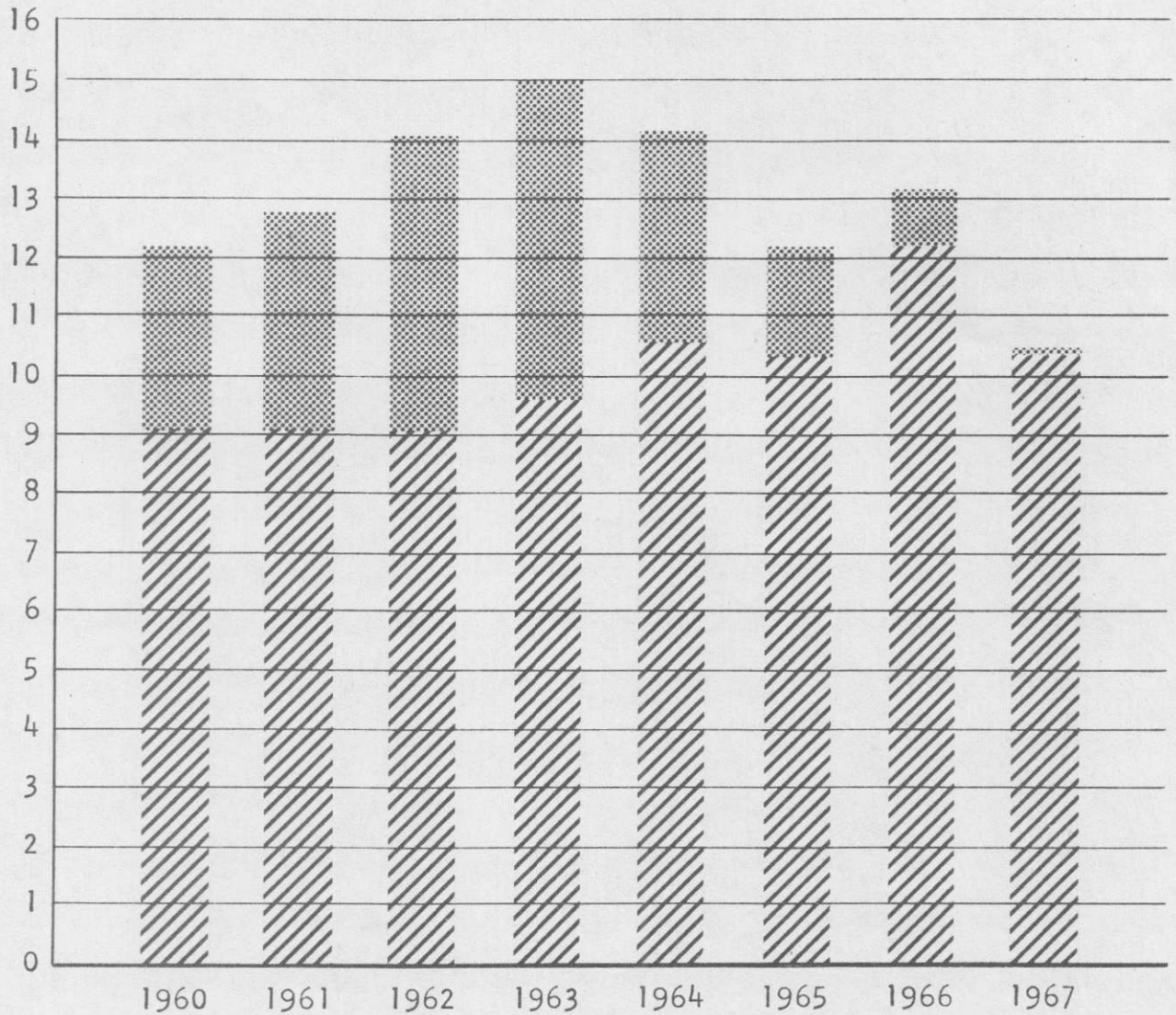

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT REVENUES, EXPENDITURES AND DEFICIT AS PERCENTAGES OF GDP, 1960-1967

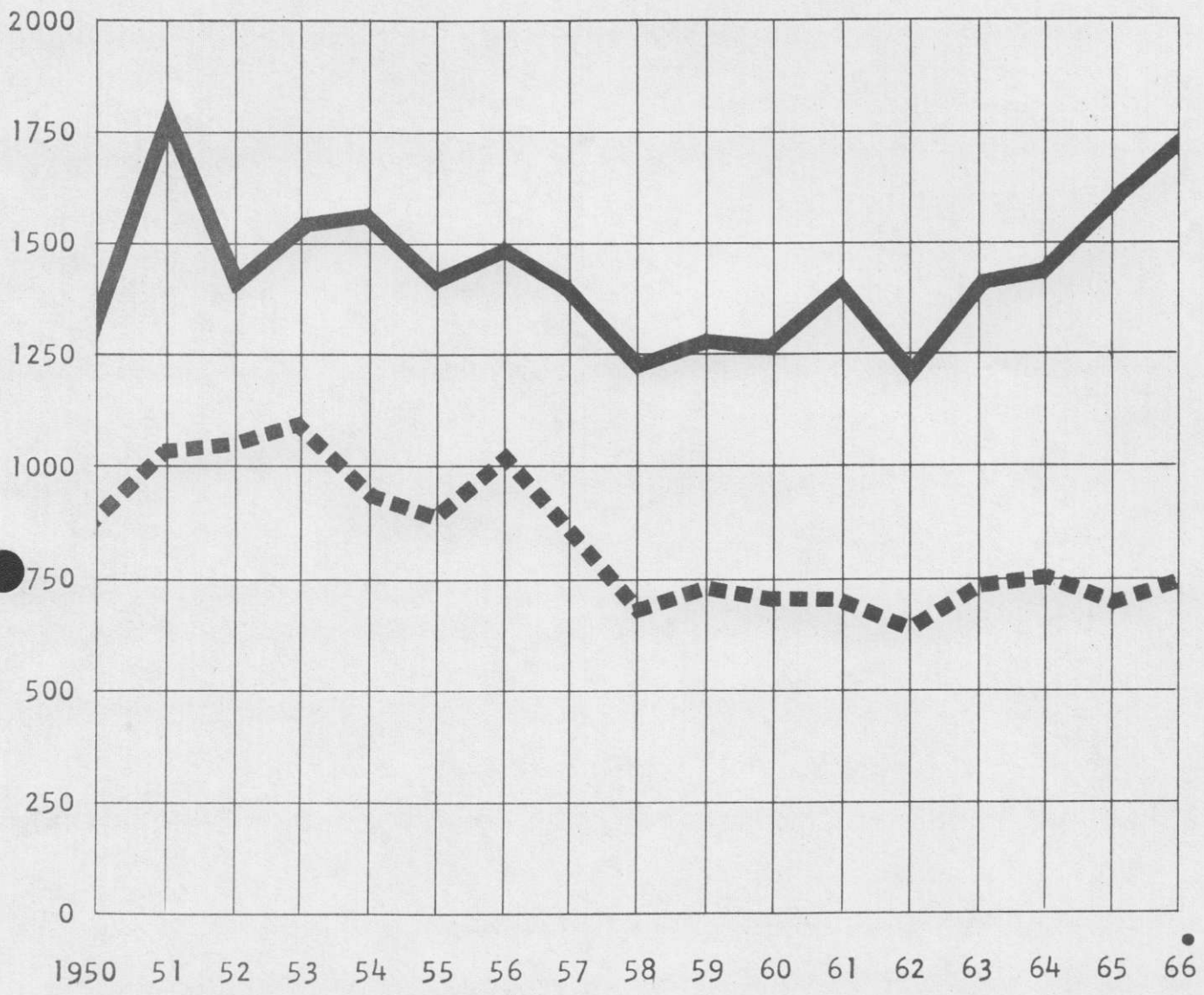
