AP story tonight March 30 reports release of House Foreign
Affairs Committee report, one of series on ideological offensive
entitled "Winning the Cold War". Committee report covers, and AP
story highlights, Department's unclassified contribution to KM
Committee report on developments in Latin America. Includes
statement Department believes that Goulart has tolerated growth
of communism in Brazil but has refused cooperate effectively
against Castro. Adds that "despite critical situation Brazil,
there is little prospect for communist takeover there in foreseeable future".

Because AP report may be widely circulated in Brazil, possibly interpreted as encouraging to Goulart, Secretary gave background briefing to UP and AP correspondents here and made following statement, which wire services were requested paraphrase and attribute only to "high official circles":
