1. PRD DEPUTY RUBEN SURO INFORMED EMBOFF OCT 21 THAT CHAMBER OPPOSITION BLOC WILL STAGE BRIEF PROTEST WALKOUT IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO ANTICIPATED FAVORABLE VOTE BY REFORMISTA MAJORITY ON SECOND
READING OF CONTROVERSIAL FORESTRY BILL. BILL APPROVED ON FIRST READING OCT. 18 IN STRAIGHT PARTY-LINE VOTE (RE F。B)。
2. EXECUTIVE ORIGINALLY INTRODUCED THIS DRAFT LEGISLATION ( WHICH TRANSFERS CONTROL AGRICULTURE SECRETARIAT S FORESTRY DIVISION TO ARMED FORCES IN MID-SEPTEMBER, CAUSING STORM OF PRESS AND OPPOSITION PROTEST (REF. A). BILL THEN REFERRED TO MIXED COMMITTEE, WHICH CHAIRED, IN EFFECT, BY PRO DEPUTY LUIS VARGAS. COMMITTEE HELD EXTENSIVE HEARINGS AND WAS
