Other Congressional sources confirm Embassy opinion synthesized last paragraph Embtel 78 that crisis will end within 48 hours with agreement between Congress and President for acceptable Primin and Cabinet and plebescite if not granting constituent powers next Congress. Consensus is president concerned with excesses disorders and warned by military is lowering demands and Congress equally concerned willing meet him half way.
