

The Abalone Alliance was formed in 1977 by activists from across the state of California who opposed the operation of the Diablo Canyon nuclear facility. The Alliance's concept of grassroots opposition to nuclear power using civil disobedience goes back to Thoreau, Gandhi and the civil rights movement. The first large scale use of civil disobedience against nuclear power occurred at Whyle, Germany and Seabrook, New Hampshire. The Alliance took its name from the thousands of Abalone killed in Diablo Cove by copper residue that was released in 1974, during testing of the reactors. Our goal of shutting down nuclear power is woven around a non-violent decentralist philosophy using consensus decisionmaking.
