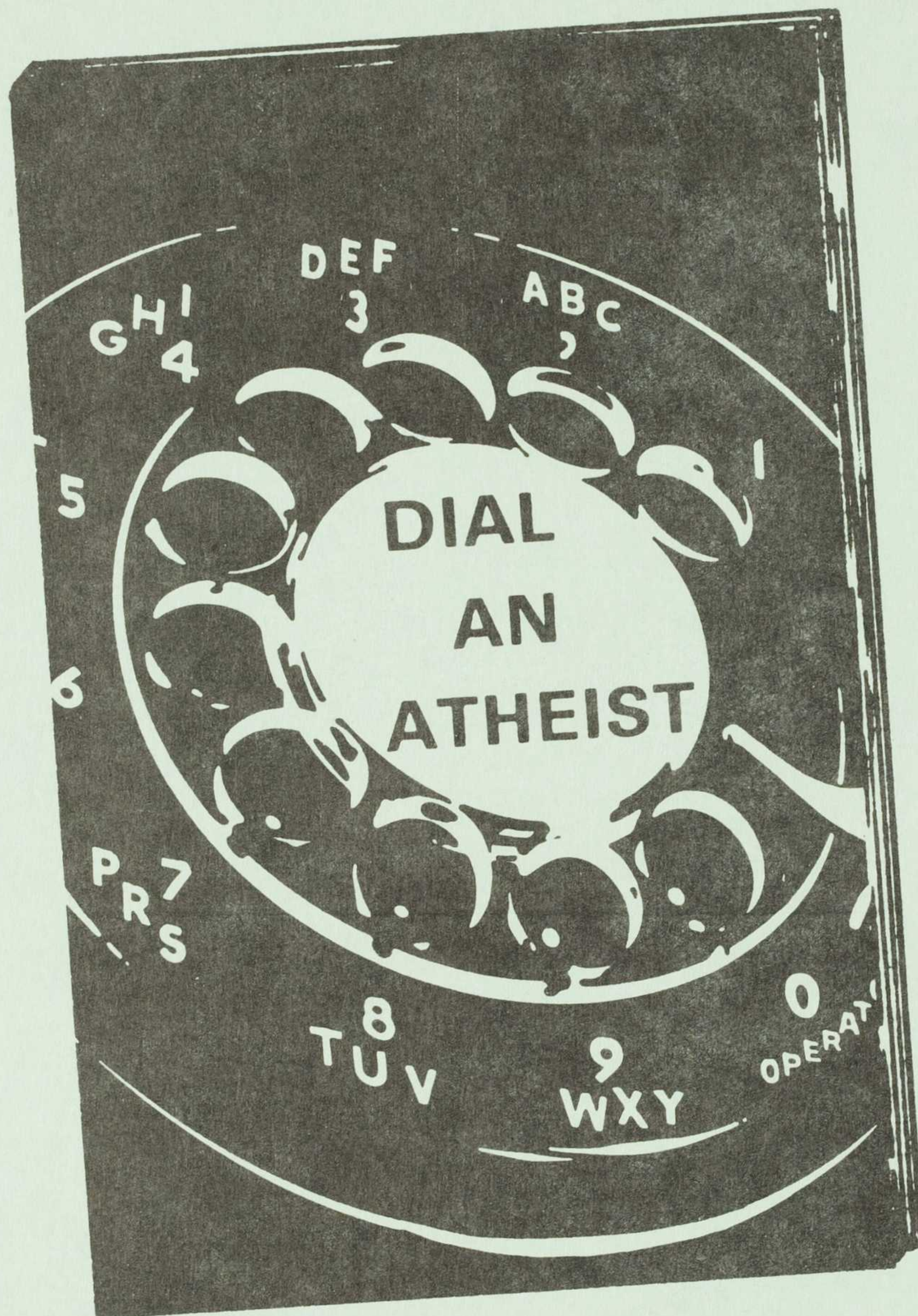


DIAL-AN-ATHEIST

A handbook of Atheist transcriptions tailored for the general public



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In December, 1979, following the example of Lloyd Thoren in Indiana (who pioneered the Dial-An-Atheist concept), the Chicago Chapter of American Atheists started a Dial-An-Atheist service with messages that changed weekly. It has run continuously and successfully ever since. As readers of *American Atheist* magazine know, there are now 26 lines of Dial-An-Atheist services being provided across the United States. It has become an established and effective method of bringing the Atheist message to the public. It promises to be even more successful in the future. So, in the interest of encouraging more Atheists to set up Dial-An-Atheist lines, American Atheists is now offering this book to help members set up their own Dial-An-Atheist message service. Of course, the book is good to read just for the sake of learning more about Atheism, too.

The Chicago Chapter of American Atheists provides in this book 52 two- to three-minute messages that it has composed in the past. Their subjects range from "the social implications of Atheism" to "religion vs. science" to "what great people have said about religion." Based on its extensive experience, the Chicago Chapter also provides you with expert advice on how to start and maintain your own Dial-An-Atheist service.

In addition, there are 38 three-minute messages that Dr. Madalyn Murray O'Hair, the world's best-known Atheist, has written and put into a section titled "Dial-THE-Atheist." These consist of the Atheist's view and concern about numerous contemporary issues into which religion has pushed itself and about numerous cases where religion has interfered with separation of church and state.

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
