LITTLE ROCK, Ark., Oct. 2 AP—Gov. Orval Faubus stood pat today on a compromise school integration proposal that was rejected by the White House. He said the next move in the racial crisis is up to Washington.

GOVERNMENT BY bayonet has superseded government by the laws of Congress in supposedly free America. The 14th Amendment, allegedly forbidding segregation, was itself ratified illegally by the pressure of military force. And, besides, the 14th Amendment says clearly that Congress—not the Supreme Court or federal troops—"shall have power to enforce, by appropriate legislation, the provisions of this article." Congress has never done so. No law forbidding segregation has ever been passed by Congress.

MOB VIOLENCE is an ugly thing, and it never looked uglier than in the press photographs from Little Rock. It is a rotten piece of business when the brawlers and bullies turn upon the outnumbered few. But it was a mob that precipitated the Boston Massacre and an organized mob in disguise which staged the Boston Tea Party. It was a mob that rioted against Soviet tanks in Poznan, and it was a mob, including many school children, which put on a race-hate riot against the Russians in Hungary. A mob acting in political protest or in patriotic indignation is not a thing to be sneeringly discounted.

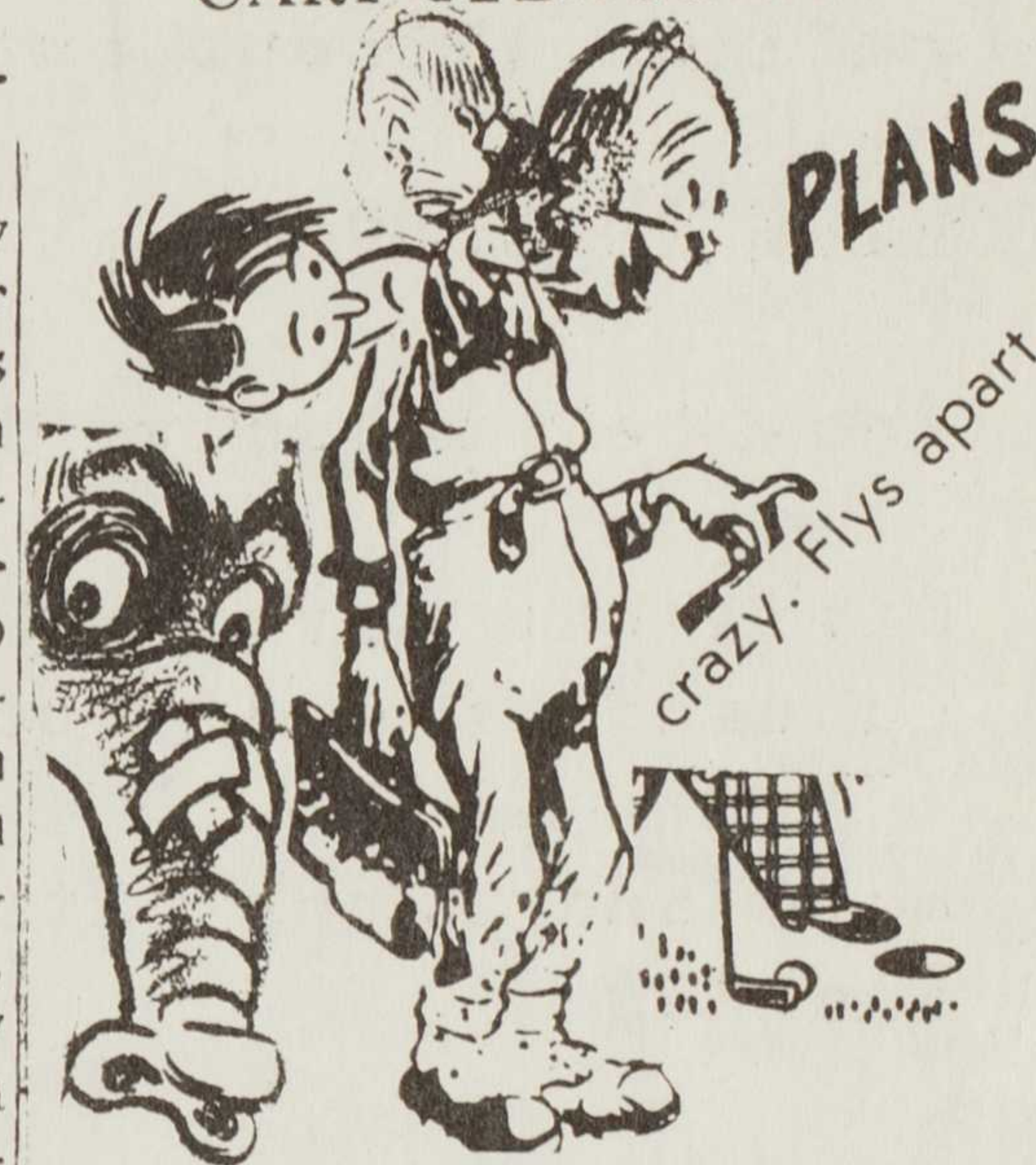

THE USE OF federal troops as a "posse comitatus" to enforce "judicial process" not only is illegal without an act of Congress authorizing it but the federal constitution requires the consent of the state for federal intervention in cases of "domestic violence." The only exceptions are in the event of a military insurrection or in wartime when Congress enacts specific laws for national defense purposes.

This law was passed in 1878 and is known as the "Posse Comitatus Act." It limits and restricts an earlier law passed in 1871 which the President cited in his official proclamation last week as justification for sending the federal troops into Arkansas.

The "Posse Comitatus Act" of 1878 reads as follows:

"It shall not be lawful to employ any part of the army of the United States, as a posse comitatus, or otherwise, for the purpose of executing the laws, except in such cases and under such circumstances as such employment of said force may be expressly authorized by the constitution or by act of Congress."

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
