NOV. 21, 1984 WAS THE KICKOFF IN WASHINGTON, D. C. FOR A SERIES OF DEMONSTRATIONS AIMED AT THE GOVERNMENT AND "APARTHEID"* POLICIES OF THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA. THEIR INTENT IS TO STOP ALL U.S. INVESTMENT IN SOUTH AFRICA.

A NEW BREED OF PICKET, CONGRESSMEN, EMERGED, TAKING PART IN THESE PROTESTS ALONG WITH OUTRAGED CLERGYMEN, CIVIL RIGHTS ACTIVISTS, AND EVEN "CONSERVATIVE" POLITICIANS... EVEN THE PRESIDENT HIMSELF EXPRESSED DISSATISFACTION WITH SOUTH AFRICA.
