of Bolivian Technicians.

Reference messages discuss turnover Mobile Seismic station presently properly on and operated by Geotecnical Corp. near Penas. Bolivia.

To Bolivian authorities represented by father Ramon Cabre, San Calix to observatory.

Embassy Aira, and USMIL group here have no objection this project provided US Air Force prepared to supply funds for maintenance of equipment, supplies and necessary salaries and expenses operations.

Embassy understands from August 26 letter from Bates, chief Vela Uniform Branch, advanced research projects agency, DODto cable that latter's proposal then in final stages of evaluation. This proposal involves at bee year budget slightly in excess of 100 thousand dollars. Embassy repeats that these funds will have to come from DOD, as Bolivian Government has no funds for this purpose.

Father Cabre has provided following names of candidates for course in Dallas beginning 19 October. Raul Jimenez and Andres de Santa Cruz. Embassy asking father Cabre airmail addition info requested your 302148Z.

FYL Geotech representatives here believe they could provide practical instruction on site, and question usefulness theoretical course in US in view candidates limited command of English.
