How much worse must it get before Congress takes action?

Here is the latest example of anti-Christian bigotry funded by the NEA.

Chrm. John Frohnmayer's NEA gave \$5,000 to help produce two books. One is titled "Queer City," the other "Live Sex Acts." The books were published by "the portable lower east side" in New York.

"Live Sex Acts," according to one source, is so filthy that **twenty publishers** refused to print it because of its hard-core pornographic content.

"Queer City" includes a blasphemous and offensive poem in which the author has Jesus sodomizing a 6-year-old boy in a church!

Here are the pertinent lines from the poem:

"I got the moon
in my throat,
I remember when
Christ ----- my ---- (*omitted words describe oral sex*)
behind the pulpit
I was 6 years old
he made me promise
not to tell no one.

Chrm. John Frohnmayer and his NEA cohorts thought enough of these two books to give a \$5,000 grant to help print them.

Not only that, but Chairman Frohnmayer further insulted the Christian community by defending the use of tax money to support the poem. He called the poem "emotional, intense and serious." "Limited excerpts from one poem in this issue have been reprinted and circulated by critics of the Endowment. These lines have been taken out of context and sensationalized. The poem, in its entirety, is emotional, intense and serious," Frohnmayer said.

Both books have this written on their title page:

"PUBLISHED WITH GENEROUS SUPPORT FROM:
the national endowment of the arts (sic)."

With our federal budget out of control, with everyone looking for ways to cut spending, with the federal deficit at record numbers, with the economy in a recession,

... why are we giving precious tax dollars to "artists" to produce hate-filled attacks which ridicule and demean our Christian faith?

Such actions are disgraceful.

And the men and women to blame are those members of Congress who have voted to continue giving our tax dollars to the NEA year after year after year despite knowing how the NEA spends those dollars.

Today I'm asking you to help end this abuse.

The first is a list of those members of Congress who voted to give the NEA your tax dollars. These are members of Congress who **know** the kinds of "art" the NEA funds, but have continued to vote to give your tax money to fund the
