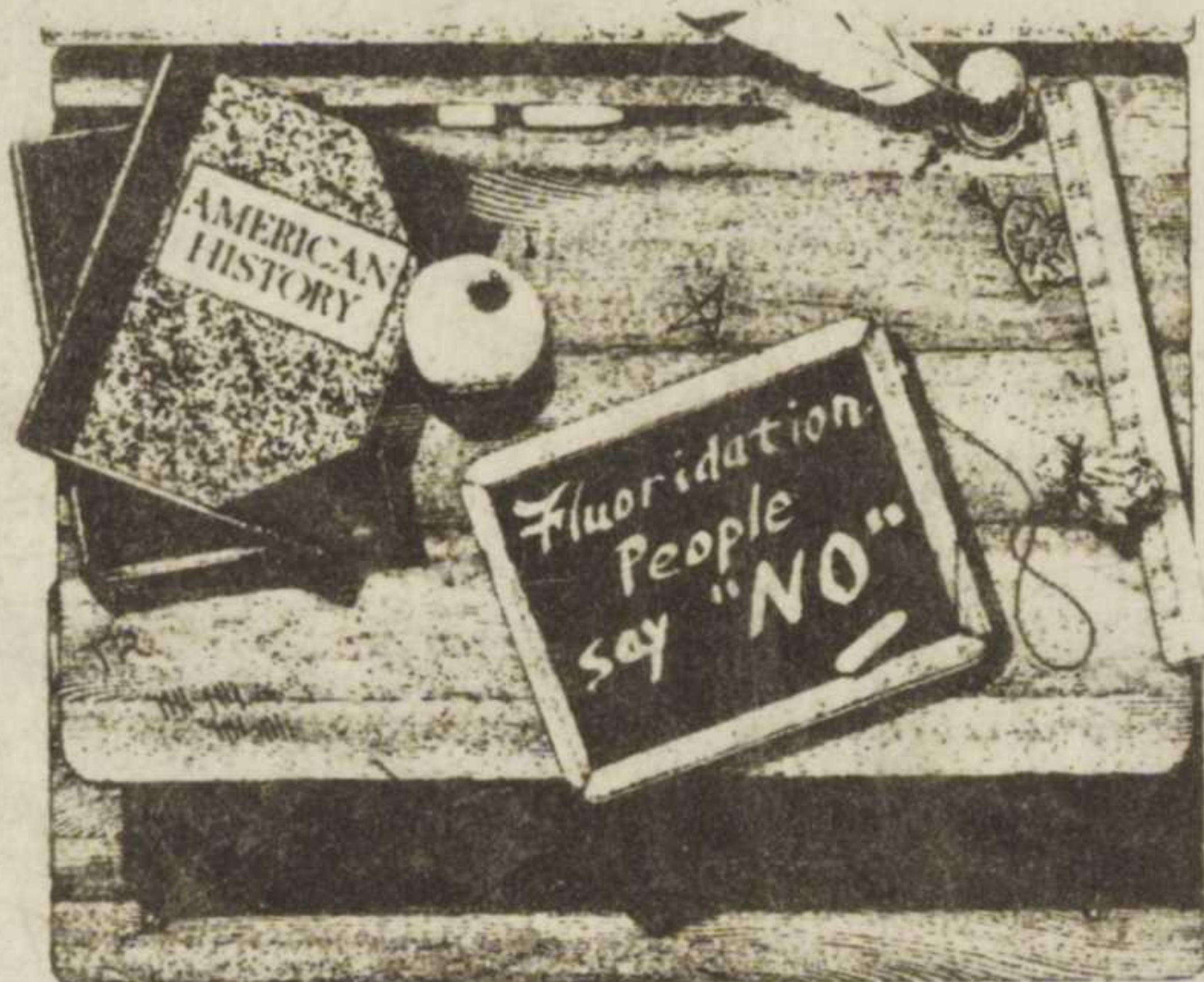


Mandatory Fluoridation Bill Introduced in Pennsylvania
