

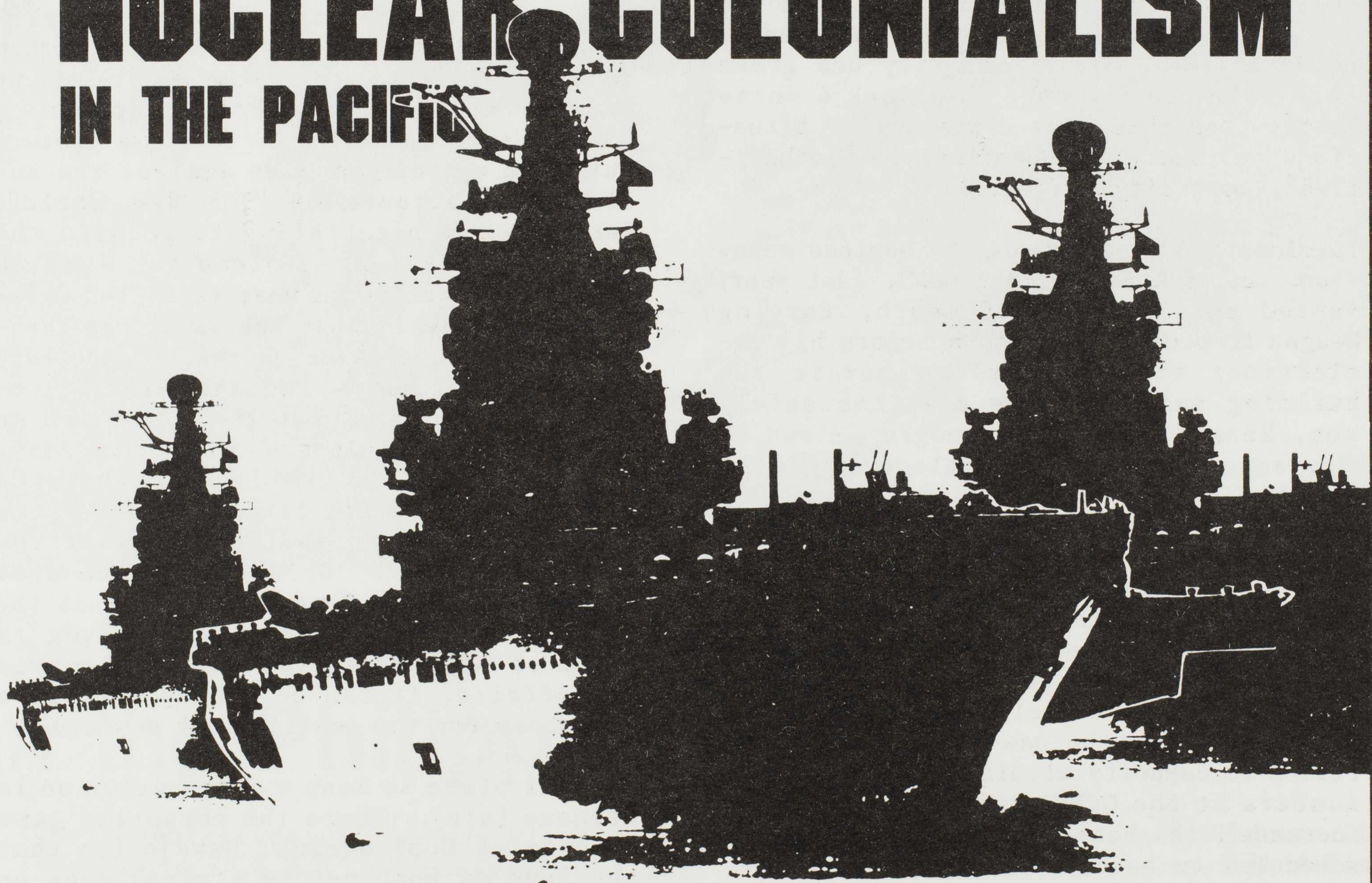

NUCLEAR COLONIALISM IN THE PACIFIC



The people of the U.S., Britain, France, Japan, and the U.S.S.R. have neither the inclination nor the power to embark on such a program of militarization as occupies, pollutes, and endangers the South Pacific today. Only governments (backed by courts, police, and military) have the ability to exercise such destructive might. The bombing in Auckland Harbor was an indication of the covert lengths to which governments will go in maintaining "independence" and "security" half a world away from home.

This summer's bombing and sinking of the Greenpeace flagship *Rainbow Warrior* in Auckland Harbor by the French DGSE (their CIA/KGB) briefly illuminated the nuclear "scene" in the Southern Hemisphere. France's testing of nuclear weapons in "French Polynesia" (against which Greenpeace has led protest flotillas for four years) are but a small part of the overall picture of the nuclear colonialism which has operated in the Pacific Basin since the end of the Second World War.
