For our Creator gave them breath, so...let them breathe out His praise! His name YAHWEH in the Hebrew is composed rather of breathings than of letters, to show all breath comes from Him.

"Let the teaching [left us by] Christ remain as a rich treasure in your hearts. In all wisdom teach and admonish one another with psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, and sing with grace in your hearts to God."
