

you're probably mad at President Johnson because:

- **There are six million more people at work**, and in higher paying jobs, since President Johnson took office; or because
- **The jobless rate has dropped** from 5.7 percent to less than four percent; or because
- **The actual number out of work has been cut** by 1½ million and the number of long-term unemployed by 565,000; or because
- **Three million older Americans have received hospital care** and 5.5 million have received physicians' services under the President's medicare program adopted in 1965.

or maybe you're mad at the President because:

- **More than 19 million elderly are protected** under the hospital insurance part of medicare, and 17.5 million by supplementary medical insurance; or because
- **An additional million persons are getting social security benefits** through amendments enacted under the President's leadership; or because
- **All 23 million social security beneficiaries are receiving monthly cash benefits** at least seven percent higher as a result of the President's 1965 amendments to the program.

or perhaps you're mad at the President because:

- **Passage of his Elementary and Secondary Education Act** is now helping **eight million disadvantaged children** through special programs in more than 17,000 communities; or because
- **Library books, text books and other educational materials have been provided for 49 million school children**—some of them may be yours—and two million teachers; or because
- **More than 135,000 needy college students are able to pursue their education through direct grants** under the President's higher education programs, and more than 198,000 others are being helped through college through part-time jobs under work-study programs.
