Key Sub-Cabinet Positions

Attached as Enclosure (1) to this airgram is a listing of the current incumbents in various key sub-cabinet level positions within the Brazilian government. Many of the persons listed have long been prominent in Brazilian public life. Others are relatively unknown. The average age of the group is around 54--further extending one of the trademarks of the cabinet itself, i.e. the average age has gone up in relation to the Goulart office holders. The apparent primary consideration for selection has been experience and/or technical competence.

Some of the individuals heading up "autarquias" are acting in the capacity of government "interventors"--especially in the labor field (IAPS). However, most of the organizations considered in this report are straight political appointments. While there has been some change-over since the revolution, most of this has been in the nature of permanent appointees replacing "interventors". It is thus presumed that there will be reasonable stability in the positions during the immediate future.

Of the roughly eighty positions (exclusive of Military commands) listed, twenty-two are currently filled by active duty or retired career military officers. Most of these officers are to be found in positions as chiefs of "autarquias" or technical billets such as those in the Ministry of Transportation and Public Works. The percentage (around 25 percent) is not significantly different from the traditional Brazilian pattern of leadership.

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Enclosure (2) to this report lists the current line-up of governors and vice-governors in the states. The appointed (military) governors of the Federal Territories are also listed.

Biographic information on some of the individuals listed is being submitted to the Department on Form FS-405's. By means of this report, constituent posts are requested to submit biographic information they may develop on the individuals concerned.
