MANUFACTURERS HANOVER which is financing the Pittston Company at the height of its efforts to bust the United Mine Workers of America. Thousands of mineworkers are now on strike, their livelihoods, families and entire communities threatened by the excessive demands of Pittston.

THE SOUTH AFRICA CONNECTION: MANUFACTURERS HANOVER not only is funding union-busting in this country, but still has \$230 million in outstanding loans to South Africa. Recently the bank has converted millions in short-term loans to 10-year loans. We must demand that the bank cease this practice, and take a tough line against South Africa in 1990 debt renegotiations. Call loans in now!

ONGOING SOLIDARITY CAMPAIGN: This emergency demonstration, called by unions supporting the United Mine Workers strike, is the first step in a campaign that will be targeting Manufacturers Hanover Trust for its strike-breaking activities in this country and support of apartheid.

It is vital for anti-apartheid activists to be making these connections in support of workers at home and abroad.

ON AUGUST 31 JOIN THE DEMONSTRATION ALONG WITH ACTWU, DC-37, DC-65, ILGWU, WRITERS UNION, AND THE COMMUNICATION WORKERS OF AMERICA IN SUPPORT OF THE UNITED MINE WORKERS.
